# Nasitip 24V 2-Seater Kids Ride-On Electric Truck

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### INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Nasitip 24V 2-Seater Kids Ride-On Electric Truck. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new electric vehicle. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure the safety of the child and prevent electric shock, fire, or serious injury, please follow these guidelines:

- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always supervise children when operating the vehicle.
- **Age and Weight Limits:** This vehicle is suitable for children aged 37-96 months (approximately 3-8 years) and has a maximum weight capacity of 66 pounds. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Protective Gear:** Ensure children wear appropriate safety gear, such as helmets and knee pads, when riding.
- **Safe Operating Environment:** Use the vehicle on flat, dry surfaces away from traffic, swimming pools, or steep inclines. Avoid operating in wet conditions.
- **Battery Safety:** Only use the provided charger and battery. Do not modify the electrical system. Keep the battery box secure.
- **Seat Belts:** Always ensure the adjustable seatbelt is securely fastened before operation.
- **No Standing:** Children should remain seated while the vehicle is in motion.

- Wheels (4x)
- Steering Wheel
- Seats (2x)
- Remote Control
- Charger

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. Adult assembly is required.

1. **Attach Wheels:** Securely attach all four wheels to the vehicle axles using the provided hardware. Ensure they are firmly in place.
2. **Connect Battery:** Locate the battery compartment, typically under the seat or hood. Connect the battery terminals according to the color-coded wires (red to red, black to black). Ensure a secure connection.
3. **Install Steering Wheel:** Slide the steering wheel onto the steering column until it clicks into place. Ensure it is properly aligned and secured.

4. **Install Seats:** Place the seats into their designated positions and secure them with the provided screws.
5. **Attach Windshield and Roll Bar:** Secure the windshield and roll bar components to the vehicle body as indicated in the diagrams.
6. **Final Checks:** Before first use, ensure all connections are tight, all screws are fastened, and the vehicle is stable.

### OPERATING YOUR RIDE-ON TRUCK

#### Driving Modes

- **Manual Driving:** Children can operate the vehicle independently using the electric pedals and steering wheel. The dashboard includes controls for power, speed (high/low), and forward/backward movement.
- **Parental Remote Control:** Parents can use the 2.4GHz remote control to steer, accelerate, and brake the vehicle. This feature is ideal for younger children or for guiding the vehicle in specific situations. The remote control can be

stored in the convenient front storage space when not in use.

- **2WD/4WD Switch:** A switch on the dashboard allows seamless transition between 2-wheel drive and 4-wheel drive modes, providing enhanced traction for various terrains.

## BATTERY CHARGING

The vehicle is powered by a 24V 7AH rechargeable battery. Proper charging ensures optimal performance and battery longevity.

- **First Use:** Charge the battery for 8-12 hours before the first use to ensure a full charge.
- **Regular Charging:** After each use, or when the vehicle's speed noticeably decreases, recharge the battery for 8-12 hours. Do not overcharge for more than 18 hours.
- **Charging Process:** Plug the charger into the charging port on the vehicle, then plug the charger into a standard wall outlet. The indicator light on the charger will typically show red during charging and turn green when fully charged.
- **Safety:** Always charge the battery in a dry, well-ventilated area. Keep the charger and battery away from water and extreme temperatures.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and performance of your ride-on truck.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Avoid spraying water

directly onto electrical components.

- **Storage:** Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture. If storing for an extended period, fully charge the battery and then disconnect it. Recharge the battery every 30 days to maintain its health.
- **Battery Care:** Do not allow the battery to completely discharge. Always recharge promptly after use.
- **Tire Inspection:** Regularly check the tires for wear and tear. Ensure they are free from debris that could affect performance.
- **General Inspection:** Periodically check all screws, nuts, and connections to ensure they are tight and secure.

| Vehicle does not move      | Battery is low or not connected; Power switch is off; Loose motor connection; Overload protection activated. | Charge battery; Turn on power switch; Check battery and motor connections; Reduce load/wait for reset.                            |
| Vehicle runs slowly        | Low battery; Overloaded; Operating on rough terrain; Motor issue.                                            | Recharge battery; Reduce weight; Operate on smoother surfaces; Contact customer support.                                          |
| Remote control not working | Remote control batteries are dead; Remote not paired; Interference.                                          | Replace remote batteries; Re-pair remote control (refer to remote manual); Move to an area with less interference.                |
| No sound or lights         | Loose wiring; Multimedia unit off; Blown fuse.                                                               | Check connections; Ensure multimedia unit is on; Check fuse (if accessible and safe to do so), contact support if issue persists. |
