Introduction

Setup and Installation

The Montex Police Gear Rack (Model PGSWM002) arrives fully assembled, eliminating the need for complex setup. Installation primarily involves securely mounting the unit to a wall.

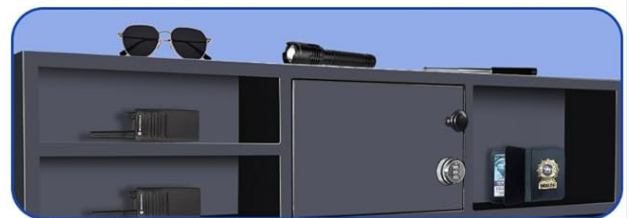
Wall Mounting Instructions:

- 1. Identify Mounting Location:** Choose a sturdy wall location. For optimal security and stability, it is highly recommended to mount the rack directly into wall studs. Using a stud finder is advised.
- 2. Mark Drill Points:** Hold the gear rack against the wall at the desired height and use a pencil to mark the locations for the mounting screws. Ensure the rack is level before marking.
- 3. Drill Pilot Holes:** Using an appropriate drill bit size for your mounting hardware (not included, as wall materials vary), drill pilot holes at the marked locations.
- 4. Secure the Rack:** Align the rack with the pilot holes and secure it to the wall using suitable screws and anchors (if not mounting into studs). Ensure all screws are tightened firmly.

- **Middle Hanger Bar:** The central hanger bar is designed for tactical vests, ensuring quick and efficient access.

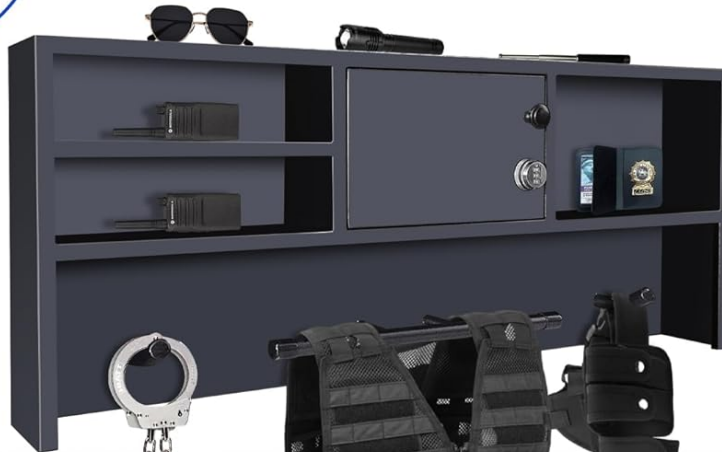

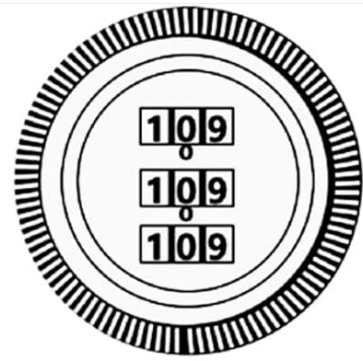
Image: The gear rack demonstrating its versatile storage capabilities for different types of equipment.

Combination Lock Operation:

The gear rack includes a concealed grid with a robust combination lock for secure storage of sensitive tools or personal items. The original password is 0-0-0.

CHANGING THE PASSWORD ONLY TAKES A FEW SECONDS TO SIMPLY PRESS AND HOLD THE BUTTON TO SET THE PASSWORD

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:

PASSWORD SETTING

1. THE PASSWORD MUST BE SET IN THE UNLOCKED STATE (THE ORIGINAL PASSWORD IS 0-0-0)
2. THE POSITION OF THE PASSWORD RESET IS THE SMALL HOLE UNDER THE BEVEL OF THE OUTER RING, ROTATE THE HEAD UNTIL YOU CAN SEE THE BUTTON INSIDE;
3. USE A SMALL ROD-SHAPED CYLINDER TO PUSH THE BUTTON AND THEN PRESS AND TURN THE CIPHER WHEEL TO SET THE CENTER POSITION OF THE NUMBER YOU WANT;
4. RELEASE THE BUTTON TO COMPLETE THE PASSWORD SETTING.

LOCK & UNLOCK

1. ROTATE TO LOCK.
2. AFTER LOCKING, SCRAMBLE ONE OR ALL OF THE COMBINATION WHEELS TO LOCK
3. WHEN UNLOCKING, DIAL TO THE SET PASSWORD TO UNLOCK.

Password Setting Instructions:

1. The password must be set in the unlocked state. The original password is 0-0-0.
2. Locate the password reset position: This is a small hole under the bevel of the outer ring. Rotate the head until you can see the button inside.
3. Use a small rod-shaped cylinder (e.g., a pen tip) to push the button. While holding the button, press and turn the cipher wheel to set the center position of the number you want.
4. Release the button to complete the password setting.

Lock & Unlock:

1. To lock, rotate the combination wheels.
2. After locking, scramble one or all of the combination wheels to secure the lock.
3. When unlocking, dial to your set password to open the lock.

Maintenance

The Montex Police Gear Rack is constructed from premium-grade metal for exceptional durability and long-lasting performance. Minimal maintenance is required.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surface with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.

- **Inspection:** Periodically check all mounting screws to ensure they remain tight and secure. Inspect the rack for any signs of wear or damage.
- **Rust Prevention:** The metal construction is designed to be rust-proof. However, avoid prolonged exposure to excessive moisture to maintain its condition.

Troubleshooting

Combination Lock Issues:

- **Difficulty Resetting Password:** Ensure the lock is in the unlocked state (set to the current password, usually 0-0-0 initially) before attempting to push the reset button. Make sure the reset button is fully depressed when setting the new combination.
- **Lock Not Opening:** Verify that you are dialing the correct combination. Ensure each number is precisely aligned with the indicator mark. If the lock was recently reset, confirm you are using the newly set password.

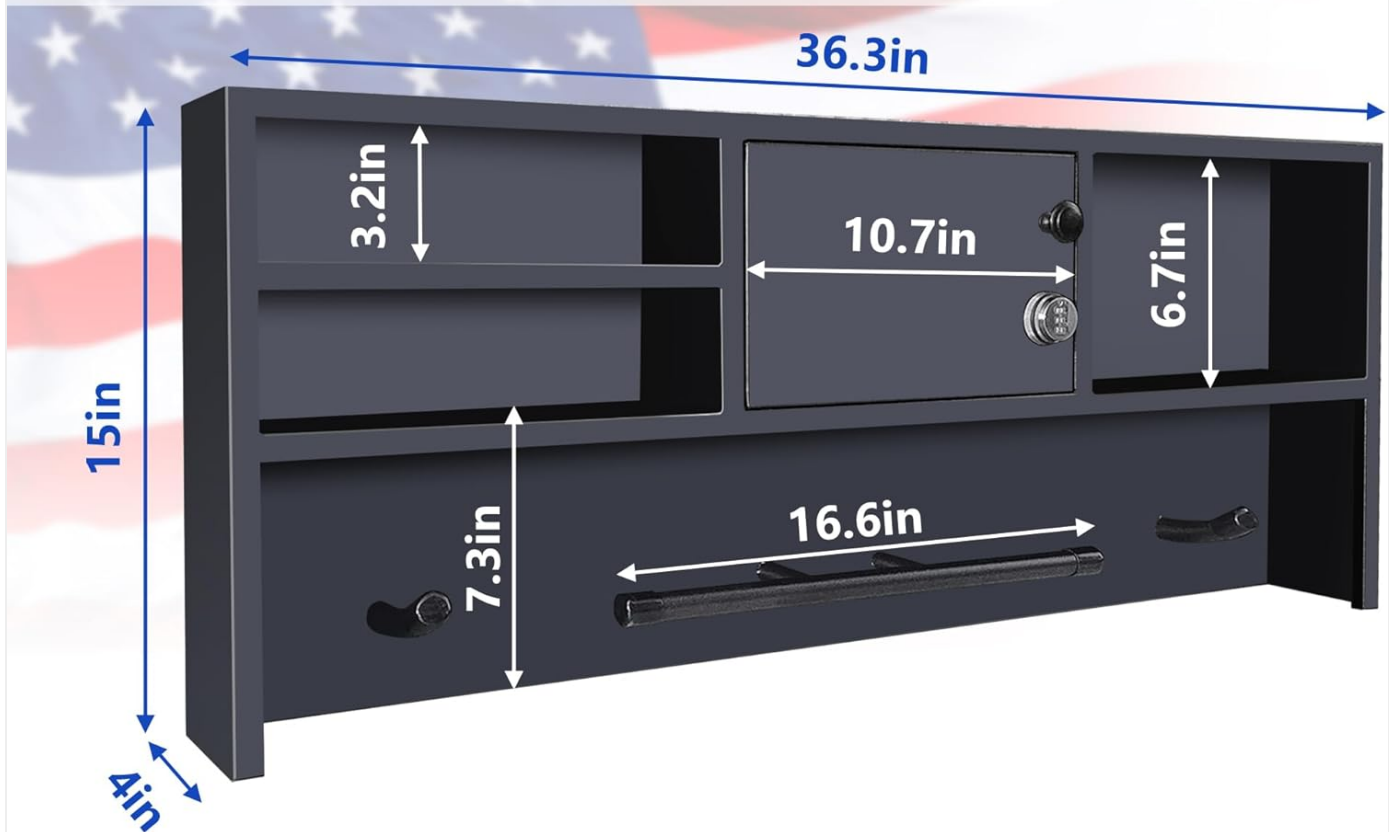
Stability Issues:

- **Rack Feels Loose:** Re-check all wall mounting screws and tighten them. If the rack was not mounted into wall studs, consider relocating it or using heavy-duty wall anchors appropriate for your wall material and the weight of the rack plus its contents.
- **Excessive Weight:** While durable, avoid overloading the rack beyond its intended capacity. Distribute weight evenly across the storage areas.
