Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Heybly 65.4" Cat Tree, Model HCT015W. This multi-level cat tower is designed to provide your feline companions with a dedicated space for climbing, scratching, playing, and resting. It features five levels, multiple scratching posts, a cozy cat condo, a plush basket, and dangling toys to encourage natural cat behaviors. This manual provides essential information for safe assembly, proper use, and maintenance of your cat tree.

Safety Information

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product must be assembled by an adult. Keep children and pets away from the assembly area until the product is fully assembled.
- **Check Stability:** After assembly, ensure all connections are secure and the cat tree is stable. Periodically check for loose parts and tighten as necessary.
- **Use Anti-Tip Kit:** For enhanced stability and safety, especially with energetic cats, always utilize the included anti-tip kit to secure the cat tree to a wall.
- **Placement:** Place the cat tree on a flat, level surface. Avoid placing it near windows without proper securing, or in high-traffic areas where it could be easily knocked over.
- **Inspect Regularly:** Regularly inspect the cat tree for any damage, such as frayed scratching posts or loose components, and address them promptly to prevent injury to your pet.

Parts List

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the diagram below for component identification. The package includes:

- Baseboard
- Various Platforms (multiple sizes and shapes)
- Scratching Posts (various lengths, wrapped in sisal rope)
- Cat Condo/House

- Plush Basket (angle-adjustable)
- Scratching Ramp
- Dangling Toys (e.g., pom-poms, rope)
- Anti-Tip Kit (wall anchor, strap, screw)
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, washers, Allen key)

Setup and Assembly

Assembly of the Heybly HCT015W cat tree is designed to be straightforward. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included manual, ensuring all labeled parts are correctly identified and used.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Clear a spacious area for assembly. Lay out all components and hardware, matching them against the parts list.
2. **Attach Base Posts:** Begin by screwing the shortest scratching posts into the designated holes on the baseboard.

Ensure they are tightened securely.

3. **Build Upwards:** Continue attaching platforms and posts layer by layer, following the numerical or alphabetical order indicated in the detailed instruction manual. Each post and platform is typically secured with screws.
4. **Install Condo and Basket:** Attach the cat condo and the plush basket to their respective positions. The basket is designed to be angle-adjustable for your cat's comfort.
5. **Add Ramp and Toys:** Secure the scratching ramp to the cat condo. Attach any dangling toys, such as pom-poms or ropes, to the designated hooks or loops on the platforms.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, re-check and tighten all screws and bolts to ensure maximum stability.
7. **Install Anti-Tip Kit:** Secure the cat tree to a wall using the provided anti-tip kit. This is a critical step for preventing accidental tipping, especially with active cats.

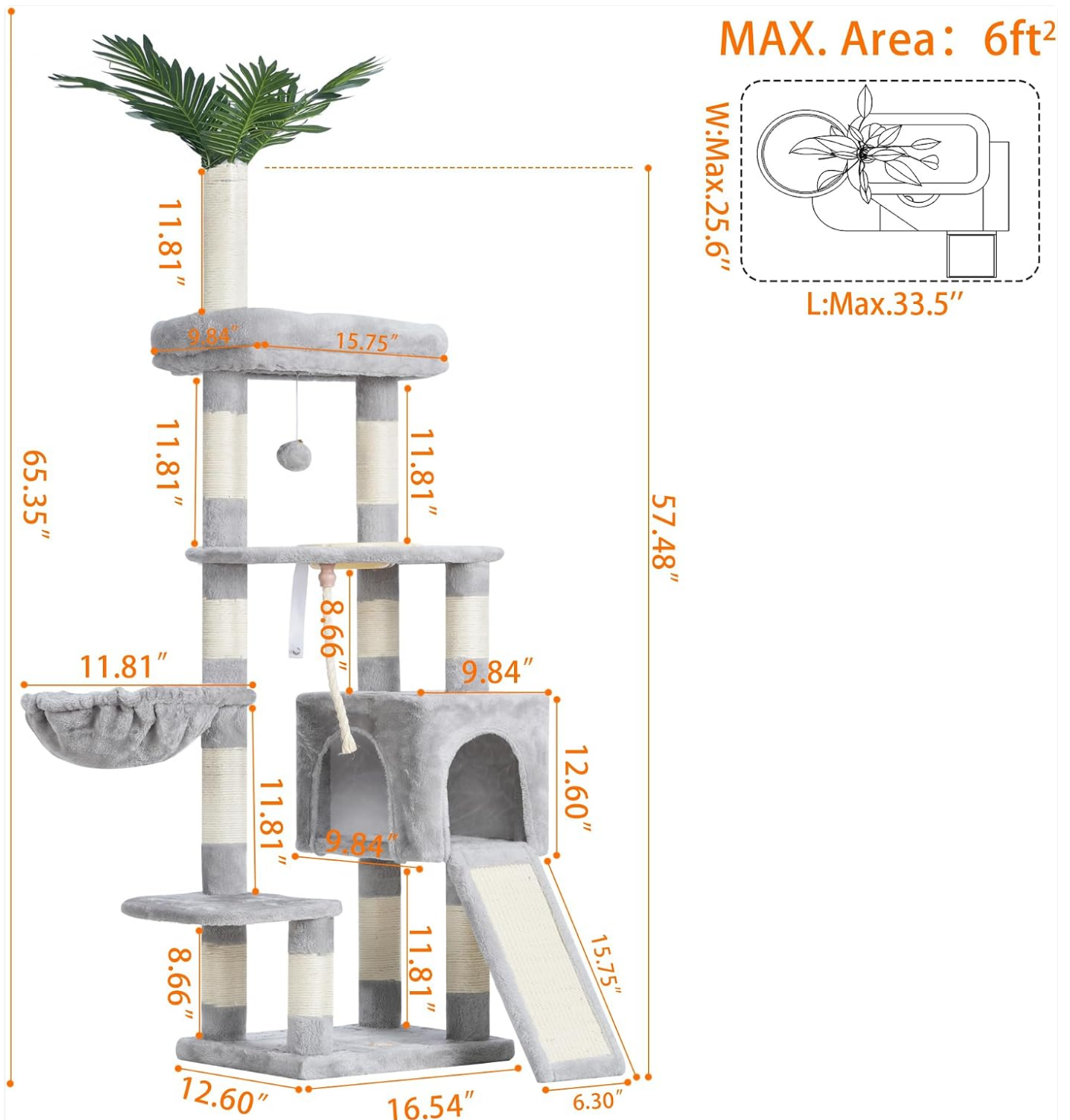


Figure 3: Anti-tip kit and dangling rope toy. The anti-tip kit should be securely fastened to a wall stud.

Operating Instructions

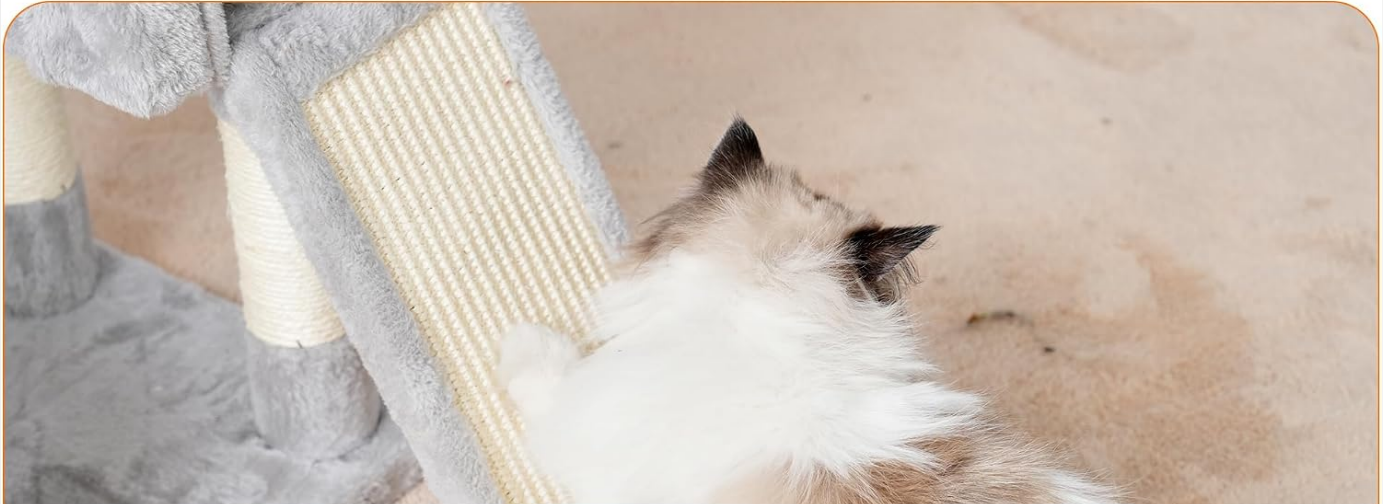
The Heybly HCT015W cat tree offers various features for your cat's enjoyment and well-being:

- **Climbing and Exploration:** Encourage your cat to explore the multiple levels. The staggered platforms make it easy for cats of all ages to climb up and down.
- **Scratching:** The numerous sisal-wrapped scratching posts and the scratching ramp provide ample opportunities for your cat to sharpen their claws, diverting them from your furniture.
- **Resting and Napping:** The padded perches, cozy cat condo, and plush basket offer comfortable spots for your cat to rest, observe their surroundings, or nap.

- **Playtime:** The dangling pom-poms and rope toys are designed to engage your cat in playful activities.
- **Feeding Area:** One of the levels includes a designated spot for a feeding bowl (fish-shaped dish), allowing your cat to eat in an elevated position.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Heybly cat tree and ensure a hygienic environment for your pet.

- **Cleaning Plush Material:** Regularly vacuum or brush the plush material to remove loose fur and dust. For spot cleaning, use a damp cloth with mild soap and water, then air dry.
- **Scratching Post Inspection:** Periodically check the sisal scratching posts for wear and tear. Severely frayed posts may need to be replaced to maintain their effectiveness and prevent ingestion of loose fibers.
- **Toy Replacement:** Dangling toys may become damaged or detached during play. Replace them as needed to keep your cat engaged and prevent choking hazards. A spare pom-pom without a bell is included for easy replacement.
- **Structural Check:** Every few weeks, inspect all screws and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain the tree's stability.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cat tree feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose connections; not secured to wall; uneven surface.	Ensure all screws are fully tightened. Use the anti-tip kit to secure the tree to a wall. Place the tree on a flat, level floor.
Cat does not use the scratching posts.	Preference for other surfaces; unfamiliarity.	Try applying catnip to the sisal posts. Gently guide your cat's paws to the posts. Ensure the posts are stable and tall enough for a full stretch.
Dangling toys are broken or detached.	Normal wear and tear from play.	Replace damaged toys with new ones. A spare pom-pom is included. Ensure new toys are securely attached.
Cat does not fit comfortably in the condo or basket.	Product size may be more suitable for kittens or smaller adult cats.	While the tree is multi-level, some enclosed spaces may be better suited for smaller cats. Ensure the basket's angle is adjusted for maximum comfort.
