PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Generic Face Neck Massager is a versatile skin rejuvenation device designed to improve skin appearance through heat and vibration. It features multiple modes to address various skin concerns.

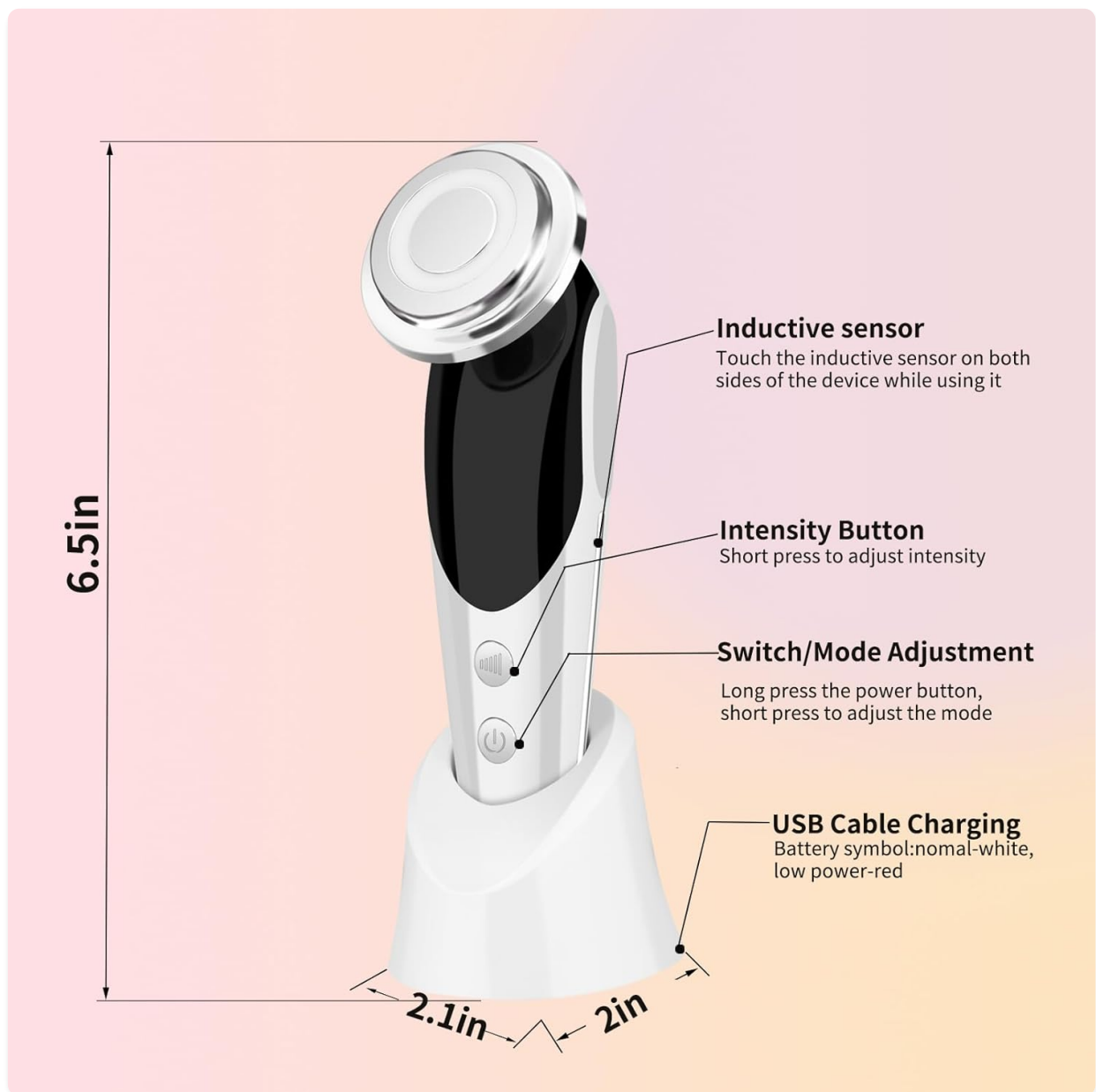


Figure 1: Device Components and Dimensions. This image illustrates the key parts of the massager, including the inductive sensor, intensity button, switch/mode adjustment button, and USB cable charging port. Dimensions are approximately 6.5 inches in length and 2.1 inches in width.

Components:

- **Inductive Sensor:** Located on both sides of the device, touch these sensors while using the device for proper operation.
- **Intensity Button:** Short press to adjust the intensity level.
- **Switch/Mode Adjustment Button:** Long press to power on/off. Short press to cycle through different modes.
- **USB Cable Charging Port:** For recharging the device. Battery symbol indicates charge status (white for normal, red for low power).

SETUP

Charging the Device:

1. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the charging port on the device.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port.
3. The battery indicator light will show the charging status. Charge the device fully before first use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before use, ensure your skin is clean and apply your preferred skincare product (serum, cream, or essence) to the area you wish to treat. Hold the device by touching the inductive sensors on both sides.

General Usage:

1. **Power On:** Long press the Switch/Mode Adjustment button to turn on the device.
2. **Select Mode:** Short press the Switch/Mode Adjustment button to cycle through the available modes.
3. **Adjust Intensity:** Short press the Intensity button to adjust the vibration intensity within the selected mode.
4. **Application:** Gently glide the massage head along the contours of your face, chin, neck, or other desired areas. Move in an upward and outward motion.
5. **Power Off:** Long press the Switch/Mode Adjustment button to turn off the device after use.

Modes and Functions:

- **Clean Mode:** Designed for thorough cleansing, helping to remove dirt from the skin.
- **Red Mode:** Aims to reduce the appearance of wrinkles and fine lines.
- **Blue Mode:** Focuses on nourishing and tightening the skin.
- **Orange Mode:** Targets anti-aging benefits and helps balance skin oil secretion.
- **Colored Mode:** Enhances the absorption of nutrient essences into the skin.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- After each use, wipe the massage head with a clean, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- Ensure the device is completely dry before storing.
- Store the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Do not disassemble the device. Any repairs should be performed by qualified personnel.

Problem	Possible Solution
---------	-------------------

Problem	Possible Solution
Device does not turn on.	Ensure the device is fully charged. Long press the power button firmly.
Device stops working during use.	The battery might be low. Recharge the device. Ensure your fingers are touching the inductive sensors.
No vibration or heat.	Check if the correct mode is selected. Ensure the device is in contact with your skin and your fingers are on the inductive sensors.
Charging indicator not working.	Ensure the USB cable is properly connected to both the device and the power source. Try a different USB port or adapter.

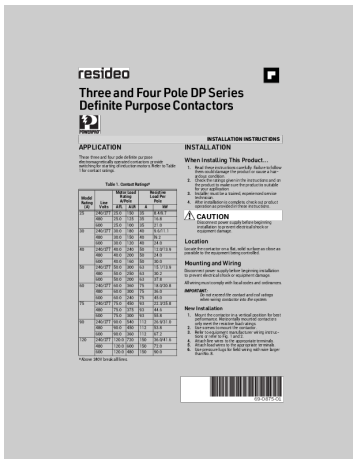
