INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, maintenance, and care of your Home Centre Quadro 3-Door Book Cabinet. Crafted from premium engineered wood with a melamine coating, this cabinet offers durable storage with three shelves behind elegant glass doors. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper functionality and longevity of your product.

SETUP

The Home Centre Quadro 3-Door Book Cabinet requires professional carpenter assembly. It is recommended to arrange for assembly by a qualified professional to ensure correct installation and structural integrity. Ensure the cabinet is placed on a flat, stable surface to prevent wobbling and ensure safety.

Assembly Overview

- Unpack all components and verify against the parts list (not provided in this manual, typically included with product packaging).
- Follow the step-by-step assembly instructions provided with the product packaging.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened.
- Install doors with butterfly hinges and tempered glass panels carefully.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Quadro 3-Door Book Cabinet is designed for storing books, decorative items, and other personal belongings. Each shelf is engineered to support a maximum weight of 7 kg.

Loading the Cabinet

- Distribute weight evenly across the shelves to maintain stability.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 7 kg per shelf. Overloading can compromise the cabinet's structure and safety.
- Place heavier items on lower shelves to enhance stability.

Door Operation

- Open and close the glass doors gently using the handles.
- Avoid slamming the doors to prevent damage to the hinges and tempered glass.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and appearance of your book cabinet.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the cabinet surfaces with a dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or excessive moisture, as these can damage the melamine coating and engineered wood.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe any spills with a dry or slightly damp cloth to prevent staining or damage to the wood.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to prevent fading or discoloration of the finish.
- **Temperature and Humidity:** Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity level. Extreme fluctuations can affect engineered wood.
- **Hinge Care:** Periodically check door hinges for tightness. If they become loose, gently tighten the screws.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cabinet wobbles	Uneven floor surface or loose assembly.	Ensure the cabinet is on a level surface. Check all assembly screws and tighten if necessary. Use shims if the floor is uneven.
Doors do not close properly	Misaligned hinges or obstruction.	Adjust the butterfly hinges. Check for any items obstructing the door closure.
Scratches on surface	Impact or abrasive cleaning.	The melamine coating offers scratch resistance, but deep scratches may occur from sharp objects. Use touch-up pens or consult a professional for repair. Avoid abrasive materials for cleaning.




