## 1. GENERAL SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Read and understand all instructions before installing and using this hot tub. Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury or death. Always supervise children. Do not use the hot tub if the cover is not securely fastened. Maintain proper water chemistry. Consult a physician before use if you have health conditions. Do not use electrical appliances near the hot tub. Ensure the hot tub is placed on a level, stable surface capable of supporting its weight when filled.

## 2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

The Wave Garda Eco Foam Hot Tub is designed for quick and easy, tool-free assembly, typically completed within 20 minutes. Follow these steps for proper installation:

### 2.1 Site Preparation

Choose a level, stable surface for your hot tub. Ensure the area is clear of debris, sharp objects, and any vegetation that could interfere with the hot tub's structure or drainage. Consider using a ground mat for added protection and insulation.

### 2.2 Assembling the Hot Tub Structure

Unpack all components. The hot tub features a durable woven UV-protected PVC exterior and a PU-insulated foam core. Assemble the foam panels according to the provided diagrams, ensuring they interlock securely. Insert the support bars into the designated grooves within the foam blocks to create a rigid structure. Once the foam structure is complete, pull the outer fabric cover up and around the panels, securing it in place.

### **2.3 Installing the Inner Liner**

Carefully place the inner bladder (liner) into the assembled hot tub structure. Smooth out any wrinkles or creases by hand, pushing the liner as far to the edges as possible. This helps prevent creases from forming once the hot tub is filled with water. Connect the filtration and heating unit to the designated ports on the liner.

Begin filling the hot tub with water. Ensure the water level is between the 'Min' and 'Max' lines indicated on the inner liner. Once filled, secure the thermal cover to help retain heat and protect the water quality.


## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

### 4.1 Filtration System

The hot tub includes an easy-to-use filtration system to keep the water crystal clear. Regularly clean and replace the filter cartridges as recommended in the detailed user manual to maintain water quality and prevent damage to the pump.

## 4.3 Cleaning and Storage

Periodically clean the hot tub's interior and exterior surfaces. When not in use for extended periods, or during colder months, drain the hot tub completely, clean it thoroughly, and store it in a dry, protected area. Ensure all components are dry before storage to prevent mold or mildew.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 5.1 No Power

- Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet.
- Ensure the circuit breaker has not tripped.
- Verify that the GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) on the power cord has not tripped. Reset if necessary.

### 5.2 Water Not Heating

- Confirm the heater function is activated on the control panel or app.
- Check the set temperature; ensure it is higher than the current water temperature.
- Ensure the filter is clean and water flow is not obstructed. A dirty filter can restrict flow and prevent heating.
- Verify the hot tub cover is securely in place to minimize heat loss.

### 5.3 Weak Bubbles

- Ensure the bubble function is activated.
- Check for any blockages in the air jets around the hot tub's interior.
