# Samsung 55 Inch DU8000 Crystal UHD 4K Smart TV User Manual

## 1. SETUP

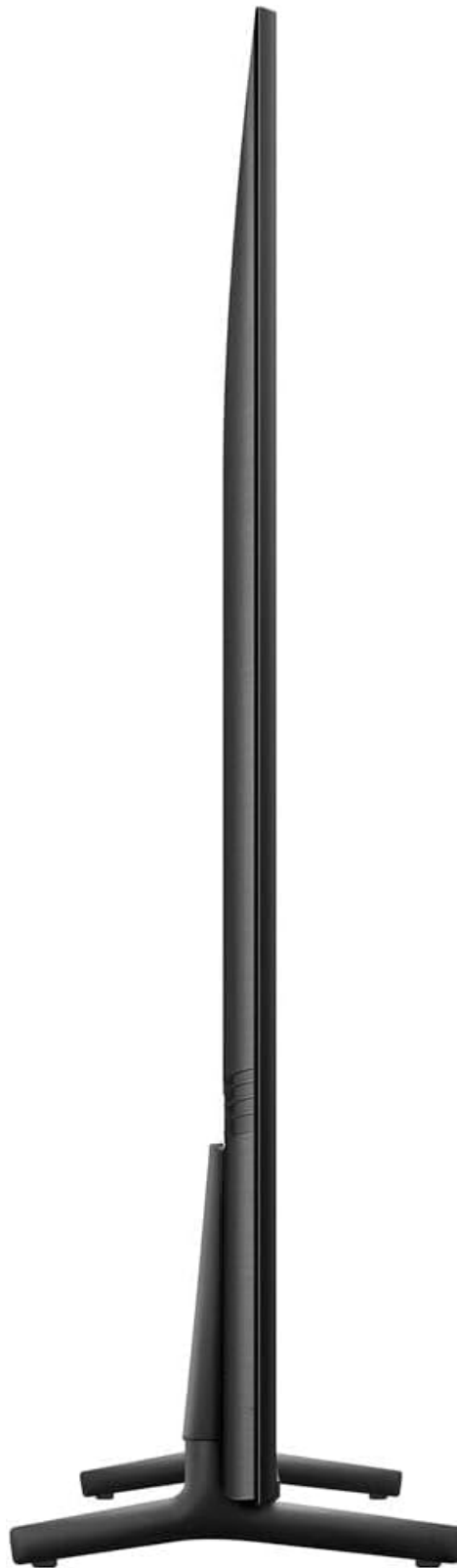

### 1.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove the TV and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components are present and undamaged. The package includes the Samsung 55 Inch DU8000 Crystal UHD LED 4K Smart TV, remote, user manual, power cord, and a Deco Gear 2X 4K HDMI 2.0 Cable bundle with CPS Exclusive 26 Month Protection Pack.

### 1.2 Attaching the Stand or Wall Mounting

For stand installation, align the TV stand with the designated slots on the bottom of the TV and secure with screws. For wall mounting, use a compatible VESA wall mount (sold separately) and follow the mount's instructions. The DU8000 features an AirSlim design for a sleek, flush fit to the wall.

### **1.3 Connecting Power and External Devices**

Connect the power cord to the TV and a wall outlet. Connect external devices such as cable boxes, gaming consoles, or Blu-ray players to the HDMI ports. The TV includes multiple HDMI 2.0 ports and USB ports. For internet access, connect an Ethernet cable to the LAN port or use the built-in Wi-Fi.

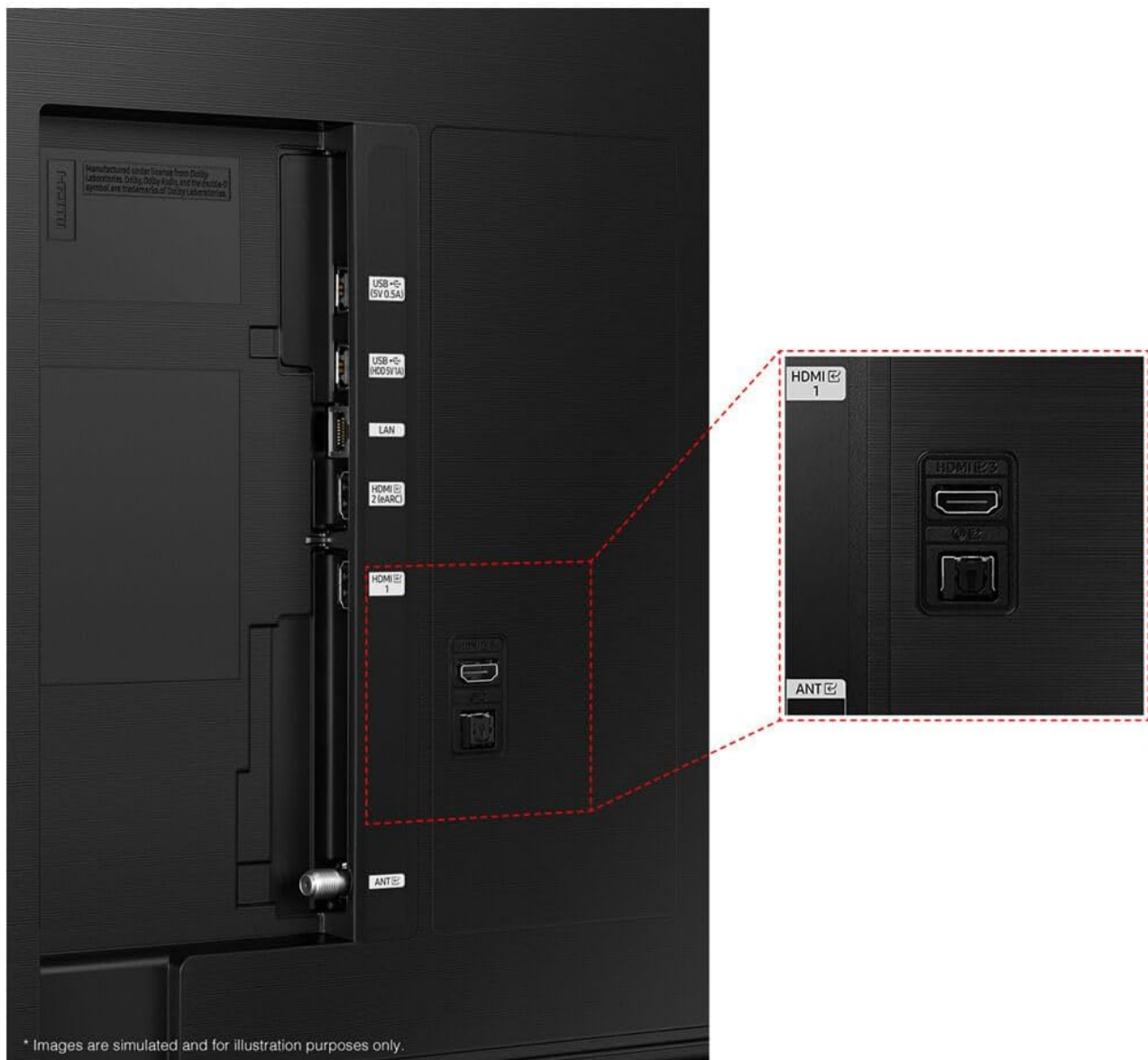


Image: Rear view of the Samsung DU8000 TV, detailing the HDMI, USB, and LAN input ports.

### 2.5 Using Voice Assistant (Alexa)

Your Samsung DU8000 TV has built-in Alexa. Press the voice assistant button on your remote and speak commands to control your TV, search for content, or get information.

## 3. MAINTENANCE

### 3.1 Cleaning the Screen

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn smudges, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

### 3.2 Software Updates

Periodically check for software updates to ensure your TV has the latest features and performance improvements. You can usually find this option in the TV's settings menu under 'Support' or 'Software Update'.



### 3.3 Power Saving Tips

To reduce power consumption, enable eco-friendly settings in the TV menu. You can adjust backlight brightness, set a sleep timer, or enable an ambient light sensor if available.

## 4. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 4.1 No Power

### 4.2 No Picture or Sound

- Verify that the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2).
- Check all cable connections between the TV and external devices.
- Ensure the volume is not muted or set too low.
- Restart the TV and any connected devices.

### 4.3 Remote Control Not Working

- Replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's sensor.
- If the remote is a Smart Remote, try re-pairing it with the TV (refer to the on-screen guide for specific instructions).

### 4.4 Network Connection Issues

- Check your Wi-Fi router and modem to ensure they are powered on and functioning correctly.
- Restart your router and modem.
- In the TV's network settings, try reconnecting to your Wi-Fi network or performing a network status test.
- If using a wired connection, ensure the Ethernet cable is securely connected.

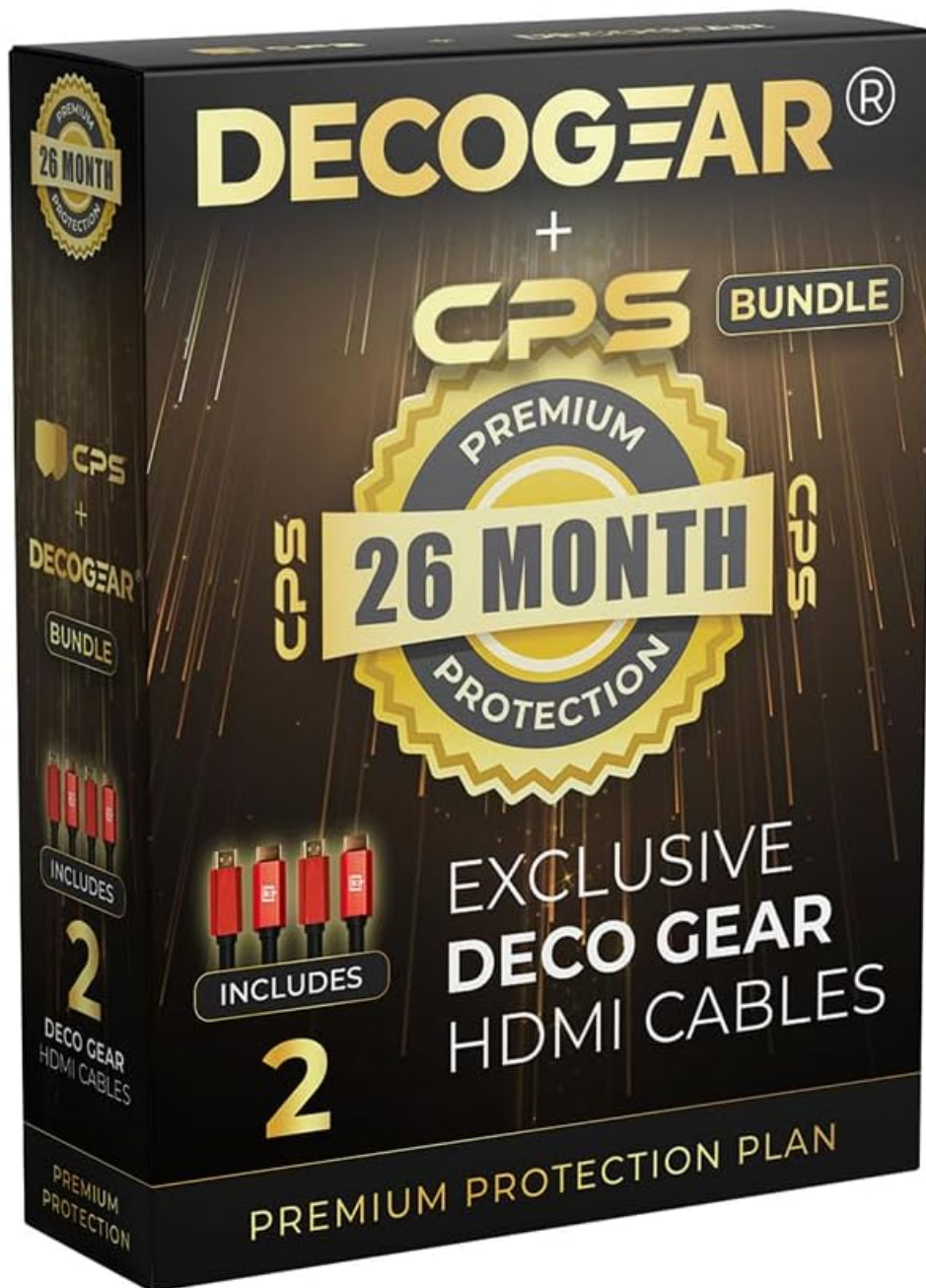


Image: The Deco Gear 26 Month Premium Protection Pack, included with the TV bundle.
