## Setup

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Install Battery:** If not pre-installed, insert the rechargeable battery into the compartment on the back of the radio. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
3. **Attach Antenna:** Screw the long-range extended antenna onto the top of the radio until finger-tight.

- Charge Battery:** Connect the USB charging cable to the radio's charging port and to the AC power block. Plug the AC power block into a wall outlet. Allow the radio to charge fully before first use. The display will indicate charging status.
- Attach Belt Clip:** Secure the belt clip to the back of the radio using the provided screws, if desired.

## Operating Instructions

- Power On/Off:** Rotate the Power/Volume knob clockwise to turn the radio on. Rotate counter-clockwise until it clicks to turn off.
- Adjust Volume:** Rotate the Power/Volume knob to adjust the listening volume.
- Select Channel:** Use the Up/Down arrow buttons on the keypad to scroll through available channels. Press the 'OK' button to confirm your selection.
- Transmit (Push-to-Talk - PTT):** Press and hold the 'PTT' button on the side of the radio to transmit your voice. Speak clearly into the microphone. Release the 'PTT' button to listen.
- Use Flashlight:** Press the dedicated Flashlight button on the keypad to activate or deactivate the built-in flashlight.
- Channel Presets:** Use the 'P1' and 'P2' buttons for quick access to your pre-programmed favorite channels.
- Dual Monitoring:** The R1 can monitor two channels simultaneously. Consult the full user manual for detailed instructions on setting up dual monitoring.
- Text Messaging (Digital Mode):** In digital mode, the R1 supports sending text messages. This can include pre-set messages or manually entered text. Refer to the full user manual for specific steps.

## Maintenance

- Cleaning:** Wipe the radio's exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Battery Care:** Fully charge the battery before extended storage. Avoid exposing the battery to extreme temperatures.
- Storage:** Store the radio in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Antenna:** Ensure the antenna is securely attached. Do not overtighten.

## Troubleshooting

- Radio does not power on:** Check if the battery is fully charged and properly installed.
- No signal or poor reception:** Ensure you are within range of another radio or repeater. Check antenna connection. Adjust squelch settings if applicable (refer to full manual).
- Cannot transmit:** Ensure the 'PTT' button is fully pressed. Verify you are on the correct channel.
- Audio is unclear:** Check volume settings. Ensure the microphone is not obstructed.




