

# 3. PRODUCT FEATURES AND DIMENSIONS

The Caliber ProTech tiles are engineered for performance and longevity. Each tile measures 9 inches by 18 inches and is 0.5 inches thick. A 24-pack covers approximately 27 square feet.




Figure 3: Anti-Slip Surface and Drainage Features

#### 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Caliber ProTech tiles are designed for easy, snap-together installation. No special tools are required for basic assembly. The tiles can be installed in four primary configurations:

- 1. Floating: Tiles are laid directly on the existing surface without being secured.
- 2. Partially Floating: Sections of tiles are secured, while others remain floating.
- 3. Fixed: Tiles are fully secured to the subfloor using the recessed fastening slots.
- 4. Partially Fixed: A combination of fixed and floating sections.

#### **Installation Steps:**

• Preparation: Ensure the subfloor is clean, dry, and level. Remove any debris or obstacles.

- Layout: Plan your desired pattern. Tiles can be combined with different colors and finishes for a custom look.
- Interlocking: Align the male and female connectors of two tiles and press firmly until they snap together. A rubber mallet may be used for a tighter fit.
- Securing (Optional): If choosing a fixed or partially fixed installation, use appropriate fasteners (not included) through the recessed slots to secure tiles to the subfloor.
- **Edging (Optional):** Install ramped edging pieces (sold separately) around the perimeter for a finished look and smooth transition.




Figure 5: Durability and Protection Features

- Stain Removal: For tougher stains, use a mild detergent and water. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the tile material.

#### 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Tiles Not Snapping Together: Ensure tiles are properly aligned. Apply firm, even pressure. A rubber mallet can assist in seating the connectors.
- **Uneven Surface:** Check the subfloor for irregularities. If the subfloor is uneven, it may cause tiles to sit improperly. Consider leveling the subfloor before installation.
- Drainage Issues: Inspect drainage channels for blockages. Lift tiles to clear any debris from the subfloor if necessary.
