1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before using the step ladder. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

General Safety Guidelines:

- **Inspect Before Use:** Always check the ladder for damage, loose rivets, or missing parts before each use. Do not use a damaged ladder.
- **Stable Surface:** Place the ladder on a firm, level, and non-slippery surface. Avoid soft ground, uneven surfaces, or areas with debris.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 330 pounds (150 kg). This includes the user and any tools or materials.
- **Proper Footwear:** Wear non-slip footwear when using the ladder.
- **Maintain Three Points of Contact:** Always maintain three points of contact (two hands and one foot, or two feet and one hand) with the ladder when climbing or working.
- **Do Not Overreach:** Keep your body centered between the side rails. Do not lean too far to the side, as this can cause the ladder to tip.
- **One Person Only:** This ladder is designed for use by one person at a time.
- **Avoid Electrical Hazards:** Do not use the ladder near live electrical wires or equipment. Metal ladders conduct electricity.
- **Secure Ladder:** Ensure the spreaders are fully locked in place before climbing.
- **Storage:** Store the ladder in a dry, secure location away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The AmazonBasics Clamber Foldable Step Ladder is designed for household tasks, offering a stable platform for reaching elevated areas. Familiarize yourself with its components before use.

Key Components:

- **Top Platform:** The uppermost step designed for standing.
- **Steps:** Individual treads for climbing.
- **Side Rails:** The main structural supports of the ladder.
- **Spreaders/Locking Mechanism:** Hinged bars that lock the ladder in an open position for stability.
- **Non-Slip Feet:** Rubber or plastic caps on the bottom of the side rails to prevent slipping.

3. SETUP AND UNFOLDING

Follow these steps to safely unfold and set up your AmazonBasics Clamber Foldable Step Ladder.

1. **Choose a Location:** Select a firm, level, and non-slippery surface for the ladder. Clear the area of any obstructions.
2. **Unfold the Ladder:**
 - Place the folded ladder on the ground with the steps facing upwards.
 - Grasp the top platform and gently pull the front and back sections apart.
 - Continue pulling until the spreaders (locking mechanism) fully extend and lock into place with an audible click.
3. **Verify Stability:** Before climbing, ensure all four feet are firmly on the ground and the ladder does not wobble. Confirm that the locking mechanism is fully engaged.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Proper use of the step ladder is essential for safety.

1. **Climbing:**
 - Face the ladder when climbing up or down.
 - Use both hands to grip the side rails.
 - Climb one step at a time, maintaining three points of contact.
2. **Working on the Ladder:**
 - Do not stand on the top platform unless it is explicitly designed for standing and you can maintain balance. For this model, the top platform is a standing surface.
 - Keep your belt buckle (center of gravity) between the side rails.
 - Avoid sudden movements or reaching too far. If you need to reach further, descend and

reposition the ladder.

- Do not use the ladder as a bridge or scaffold.

3. Descending:

- Face the ladder and descend slowly, maintaining three points of contact.
- Ensure each foot is securely placed on a step before shifting your weight.

Folding the Ladder for Storage:

1. Ensure no one is on the ladder.
2. Locate the locking mechanism/spreaders.
3. Carefully disengage the locking mechanism (this may require a slight push or pull on the spreaders, depending on the design).
4. Gently push the front and back sections together until the ladder is fully folded.
5. Secure any straps or latches if present to keep it folded.

5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your step ladder.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the ladder clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish or materials.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all components for wear, damage, or loose parts. Pay close attention to:
 - Rivets and fasteners: Ensure they are tight and secure.
 - Steps and platform: Check for cracks, bends, or excessive wear.
 - Non-slip feet: Ensure they are intact and not worn smooth. Replace if necessary.
 - Locking mechanism: Verify it engages and disengages smoothly and securely.
- **Lubrication:** If the locking mechanism feels stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the pivot points.
- **Storage:** Store the ladder in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Store it in its folded position to save space and protect it from accidental damage.
- **Repairs:** Do not attempt to repair damaged parts yourself. Contact customer support for assistance or replacement parts.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your step ladder.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ladder wobbles when set up.	Uneven surface; locking mechanism not fully engaged.	Move ladder to a firm, level surface. Ensure spreaders are fully locked.
Ladder difficult to unfold/fold.	Mechanism stiff or dirty; obstruction.	Clean and lubricate pivot points with silicone spray. Check for debris.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Non-slip feet are worn or missing.	Normal wear and tear; accidental loss.	Do not use the ladder. Contact customer support for replacement feet.
