## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and maintenance of your Seago compatible replacement brush heads for kids' electric toothbrushes. These brush heads are designed to provide effective and gentle cleaning for children aged 3 years and older, ensuring optimal oral hygiene.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

These replacement brush heads feature super soft nylon bristles, specifically designed for children's sensitive gums. The bristles are rounded to ensure careful cleaning and gum massage. The curved design allows for thorough cleaning in hard-to-reach areas.

### Key Features:

- **Super Soft Bristles:** Gentle on tender gums, made from DuPont nylon.
- **Curved Design:** Reaches difficult areas for comprehensive cleaning.
- **Effective Cleaning:** Transforms toothpaste into rich bubbles for thorough cleaning along the gum line and between teeth.
- **Food-Grade Material:** Made of food-grade rubber for safety.
- **Compatibility:** Designed for various Seago kids electric toothbrush models, including SG513, SG977, SGEK6, DT-K6, EK2, EK5, EK6, C5, C6, C8, SG-513, 628, 623, SG915, and SGEK7.

### 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Replacing the brush head on your Seago kids electric toothbrush is a simple process.

1. **Remove Old Head:** Gently twist the old brush head counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it from the toothbrush handle.
2. **Attach New Head:** Align the new replacement brush head with the shaft of the toothbrush handle.
3. **Secure New Head:** Twist the new brush head clockwise until it locks securely into place. Ensure it is firmly attached before use.

### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Once the brush head is installed, the electric toothbrush operates as usual. These brush heads are designed to work with the existing brushing modes of your compatible Seago electric toothbrush.

1. **Apply Toothpaste:** Apply a pea-sized amount of children's toothpaste to the bristles of the new brush head.

2. **Start Brushing:** Place the brush head against your child's teeth at a slight angle towards the gum line. Turn on the electric toothbrush.
3. **Guide the Brush:** Gently guide the brush head slowly across all surfaces of the teeth, allowing the electric toothbrush to do the work. Do not scrub vigorously.
4. **Brush All Areas:** Ensure all areas of the mouth are brushed, including the front, back, and chewing surfaces of the teeth.
5. **Rinse:** After brushing, turn off the toothbrush, remove the brush head, and rinse both the brush head and the toothbrush handle thoroughly under running water.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and effectiveness of your brush heads and promotes good oral hygiene.

- **Rinse After Use:** Always rinse the brush head thoroughly after each use to remove toothpaste residue and food particles.
- **Air Dry:** Allow the brush head to air dry in an upright position to prevent bacterial growth.
- **Replacement Frequency:** For optimal performance and hygiene, it is recommended to replace the brush head every 3 months, or sooner if the bristles become frayed or worn.

**Suggest replacing the toothbrush head within 2-3 months**

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your replacement brush heads, consider the following:

- **Brush Head Not Fitting Securely:**
  - Ensure the brush head is correctly aligned and twisted clockwise until it locks.
  - Verify that the brush head is compatible with your specific Seago electric toothbrush model (refer to Section 2).
- **Bristles Fraying Quickly:**
  - This may indicate excessive pressure during brushing. Encourage your child to use a lighter touch.
  - Replace the brush head if bristles are significantly frayed, as effectiveness will be reduced.
- **Ineffective Cleaning:**
  - Ensure the brush head is replaced every 3 months as recommended. Worn bristles are less effective.
  - Confirm proper brushing technique, ensuring all tooth surfaces are covered.
