INTRODUCTION

SETUP GUIDE

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the tablet, protective case, charging cable, and power adapter are present. Inspect the tablet for any physical damage.

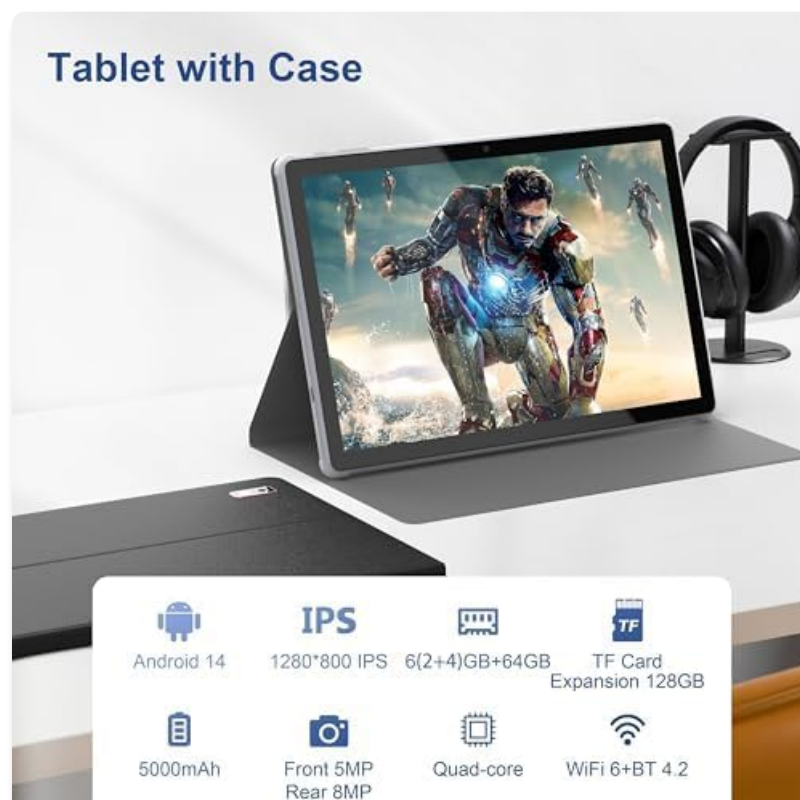

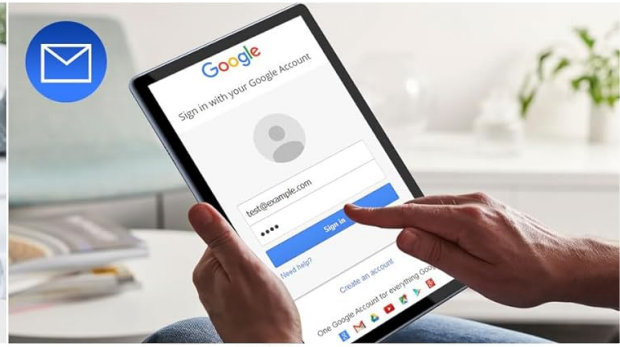

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your Tablet

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

2. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to **Settings > System > System update** to check for updates.

3. Battery Care

To prolong battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not let the battery drain completely before recharging frequently.
- Unplug the charger once the battery is full.

4. Storage Management

Periodically review your installed applications and files. Uninstall unused apps and delete unnecessary files to free up storage space and maintain optimal performance. Utilize the microSD card slot for additional storage if needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tablet does not turn on.	Low battery; system crash.	Charge the tablet for at least 30 minutes. Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force restart. If unresponsive, locate the small reset pinhole (refer to diagram in Setup Guide) and gently press it with a paperclip.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Incorrect password; router issue; tablet Wi-Fi off.	Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in Settings. Re-enter Wi-Fi password. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network and reconnect.
Slow performance.	Too many apps running; low storage; outdated software.	Close background apps. Clear cache. Uninstall unused apps. Check for system updates. Restart the tablet.
Apps crashing or freezing.	App bug; insufficient resources.	Force close the app (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Force Stop). Clear app cache/data. Reinstall the app. Ensure system is updated.
