1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the SWAREY V8 Motorcycle Bluetooth Headset. This device is designed to enhance your riding experience by providing seamless communication, music playback, and call management while on the road. Featuring advanced noise cancellation, multi-person intercom capabilities, and long battery life, the V8 headset ensures clear audio and reliable performance. Please read this manual carefully to understand the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your new headset.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND PACKAGE CONTENTS

The SWAREY V8 Motorcycle Bluetooth Headset comes as a dual pack, providing two complete units for rider-to-rider communication. Each unit is equipped with essential features for a connected ride.

2.1 Package Contents

- 2 x SWAREY V8 Bluetooth Headset Units
- 2 x Headset Speakers with Microphones
- 2 x USB Type-C Charging Cables
- 2 x Clip-on Mounting Brackets
- 2 x 3M Adhesive Mounting Brackets

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation ensures optimal performance and comfort. The V8 headset offers two main installation methods for the main unit and a straightforward process for the speakers and microphone.

3.1 Main Unit Installation

You can choose between a clip-on installation or a 3M adhesive attachment.

3.1.1 Clip-on Installation

1. Attach the clip-on bracket to the main V8 unit.
2. Slide the bracket onto the edge of your helmet, ensuring it is securely fastened.

3.1.2 3M Adhesive Installation

1. Peel off the protective film from the 3M adhesive pad on the bracket.
2. Firmly press the bracket onto a clean, flat surface on your helmet. Allow sufficient time for the adhesive to bond before attaching the main unit.
3. Slide the main V8 unit onto the attached adhesive bracket.

3.2 Speaker and Microphone Installation

1. Open the inner lining of your helmet.
2. Attach the speakers to the ear pockets inside the helmet using the provided adhesive pads. Ensure they are positioned directly over your ears for optimal sound.
3. Route the microphone cable to the front of the helmet, positioning the microphone near your mouth for clear voice pickup. Secure excess cables within the helmet lining.
4. Close the helmet lining, ensuring no cables are pinched.

3.3 Power On/Off

To power on the device, press and hold the "Intercom Key" and "Multifunction Key" simultaneously for 2 seconds. The blue indicator light will turn on, and you will hear a sound prompt: "Power On." To power off, repeat the same action.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SWAREY V8 headset offers various modes for communication and entertainment.

4.1 Pairing for Two-Person Intercom Mode

1. After powering on both V8 units, press and hold the intercom key on both devices for 2 seconds. The indicator lights will flash red and blue alternately, with a sound prompt: "Pairing."
2. On one device, press the intercom key once. You will hear a sound prompt: "Two-Person Mode." The indicator light will flash red and blue quickly.
3. Wait for the green indicator light to turn on; when it flashes slowly, pairing is successful, and you will hear the sound prompt: "Intercom Connected." You will then enter two-person intercom mode.

4.2 Pairing for Multi-Person Intercom Mode (Up to 4 Riders)

1. After powering on all V8 units (up to 4), press and hold the intercom key on each device for 2 seconds. The indicator

lights will flash red and blue alternately, with a sound prompt: "Pairing."

2. On one device, double-click the intercom key. You will hear a sound prompt: "Multi-Person Networking Mode." The indicator light will flash red and blue quickly.
3. Wait for the green indicator light to turn on; when it flashes slowly, pairing is successful, and you will hear the sound prompt: "Intercom Connected." You will then enter multi-person intercom mode. A slowly flashing green indicator light indicates successful pairing of multiple devices.

4.3 Bluetooth Signal Activation (Connecting to Phone)

After powering on the V8 unit, press and hold the multifunction key for 3 seconds. You will hear a sound prompt: "Pairing." On your mobile phone, enable Bluetooth and search for "V8" in the list of available devices. Select "V8" to connect. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation sound.

4.4 Music Playback

- ****Pause/Start Playback****: Single-click the multifunction key to pause or start music playback.
- ****Volume Control****: Single-click the "+" or "-" keys to adjust the volume.
- ****Next/Previous Track****: Long-press the "+" key for the next track, and long-press the "-" key for the previous track.

4.5 Voice Assistant

Single-click the voice assistant key (microphone icon) to activate your phone's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).

4.6 Call Management

- ****Answer/End Call****: Single-click the multifunction key to answer an incoming call or end an ongoing call.
- ****Reject Call****: Double-click the multifunction key to reject an incoming call.
- ****Automatic Answering****: The headset supports automatic answering of incoming calls after a few rings.

4.7 Music Sharing Function in Two-Person Intercom Mode

When the intercom headphones are connected to both the intercom and a music player (via Bluetooth), simultaneously press and hold the "Volume +" and "Volume -" buttons on the unit playing music. You will hear a sound prompt: "Music Sharing," allowing you to share the music you're listening to with another intercom headphone.

4.8 Connecting to Non-Intercom Bluetooth Devices

In two-person intercom mode, to match intercom headphones with other Bluetooth devices that do not have intercom functionality (e.g., standard Bluetooth headphones), power on the V8 unit. Then, press and hold the intercom key on the V8 unit. The indicator light will flash red and blue quickly, activating Bluetooth. At the same time, turn on the Bluetooth signal of

the other device to search for signals. Then single-click the intercom key on the V8 unit to connect.

4.9 FM Radio

The V8 headset includes an FM radio function. Refer to the quick start guide for specific button presses to activate and scan FM stations.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your SWAREY V8 headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior of the headset. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they may damage the surface.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Charging:** Always use the provided USB Type-C charging cable. Avoid overcharging the battery.
- **Water Resistance:** The headset is water-resistant, but it is not fully waterproof. Avoid submerging the device in water or exposing it to heavy rain for prolonged periods.
- **Cable Care:** Handle the speaker and microphone cables gently to prevent damage. Ensure they are not pinched or excessively bent during installation or removal.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SWAREY V8 headset, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the headset to a power source using the USB Type-C cable.
- **Cannot Pair:** Make sure both devices are in pairing mode (flashing red and blue alternately). Ensure no other Bluetooth devices are interfering with the pairing process. Try resetting the devices by powering them off and on again.
- **No Sound/Low Volume:** Check the volume levels on both the headset and the connected device (phone/intercom). Ensure speakers are correctly positioned inside the helmet.
- **Intercom Disconnection:** Ensure both units are within the specified communication range (1000m for two-person, 2500m for multi-person). Obstacles and terrain can affect range.
- **Poor Audio Quality/Noise:** Ensure the microphone is positioned correctly and not obstructed. Check for external interference. The headset features DSP&CVC noise cancellation, but extreme noise environments may still impact

clarity.

- **FM Radio Interference:** Radio reception can be affected by location and environmental factors. Try moving to an open area or adjusting your position.
