1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Storage:** Store the appliance in a cool, dry place when not in use. Ensure the unit is completely cool and empty of water before storing.

4. SETUP

4.1 Attaching Accessories

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the control panel to adjust the steam output volume according to your cleaning needs. Hold the spray handle to release steam.

5.3 Cleaning Techniques

Direct the steam nozzle towards the surface to be cleaned. For stubborn dirt, use appropriate brush attachments and apply steam while scrubbing gently. Always test on an inconspicuous area first.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam output	No water in tank, unit not heated, power issue	Fill water tank, wait for heating, check power connection
Low steam pressure	Low water level, nozzle blockage	Refill water, clean nozzle and attachments
Water leaking	Water tank cap not secured, overfilled tank, damaged seal	Ensure cap is tight, do not overfill, contact support if seal is damaged
Unit not turning on	No power, faulty power cord	Check power outlet, ensure cord is fully inserted, try another outlet
