INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts listed in the packing list are present.

2. **Charge the Battery:** Before initial use, fully charge the lithium-ion battery. Connect the charger to the vacuum unit and plug it into a standard electrical outlet. A full charge typically takes 4 hours.

- 3. **Assemble the Pole:** Connect the four 14-inch PVC pipe sections to form the full 45-inch pole. Attach the pole adapter to the main unit, then secure the assembled pole to the adapter.
- 4. **Attach Vacuum Head:** Select the appropriate vacuum head (either the 7.5-inch wide vacuum head with soft-bristle brush or the crevice corner nozzle) and attach it securely to the main unit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The POOL BLASTER Pulse is designed for efficient and hassle-free pool cleaning.

- 1. **Submerge the Vacuum:** Fully submerge the vacuum unit into the water. Ensure the vacuum head is completely underwater before activating.
- 2. **Activate the Unit:** Press the On/Off button located on the motor box to start the vacuum. The unit will begin to draw water and debris into the debris chamber.
- 3. **Begin Cleaning:** Guide the vacuum along the bottom and sides of your pool, hot tub, or spa. The 7.5-inch wide vacuum head is effective for general cleaning, while the crevice corner nozzle is ideal for tight spaces and steps.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your POOL BLASTER Pulse.

1. **Emptying the Debris Chamber:** After each use, or when the debris chamber is full, empty its contents. The unique dual-cam lever connection allows for easy and quick emptying.

- 2. **Cleaning the Filter Bag:** Remove the Xtreme Multilayered Filter Bag from the debris chamber and rinse it thoroughly with a garden hose. Ensure all debris is removed before reinserting.
- 3. **Recharging:** Recharge the unit after each use to ensure it is ready for the next cleaning session. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours. Store the unit in a dry, cool place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your POOL BLASTER Pulse, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum not turning on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the unit for 4 hours.
Reduced suction power.	Debris chamber is full or filter bag is clogged.	Empty the debris chamber and clean the filter bag thoroughly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit stops unexpectedly.	Battery is low or unit is overheated.	Recharge the battery. If overheated, allow the unit to cool down before resuming operation.
Debris escaping back into pool.	Filter bag not properly seated or damaged.	Ensure the filter bag is correctly installed. Inspect for damage and replace if necessary.
