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INTRODUCTION

The Retrospec Scout Toddler Bike Helmet is designed to provide safety and comfort for young riders engaging in various activities such as biking, scootering, skateboarding, and roller skating. This manual contains important instructions for the correct assembly, fitting, use, and maintenance of your helmet to ensure maximum protection.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when using this helmet. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death.

- This helmet is CPSC Certified and meets U.S. safety standards for ages 1 and up.
- The helmet features an impact-absorbing EPS foam lining and a durable PVC outer shell for protection.
- Always ensure the helmet fits snugly and is securely fastened before any activity.
- A helmet cannot protect against all possible impacts. Replace the helmet after any significant impact, even if visible damage is not apparent.
- Do not modify or paint the helmet, as this may compromise its protective capabilities.
- **WARNING:** This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

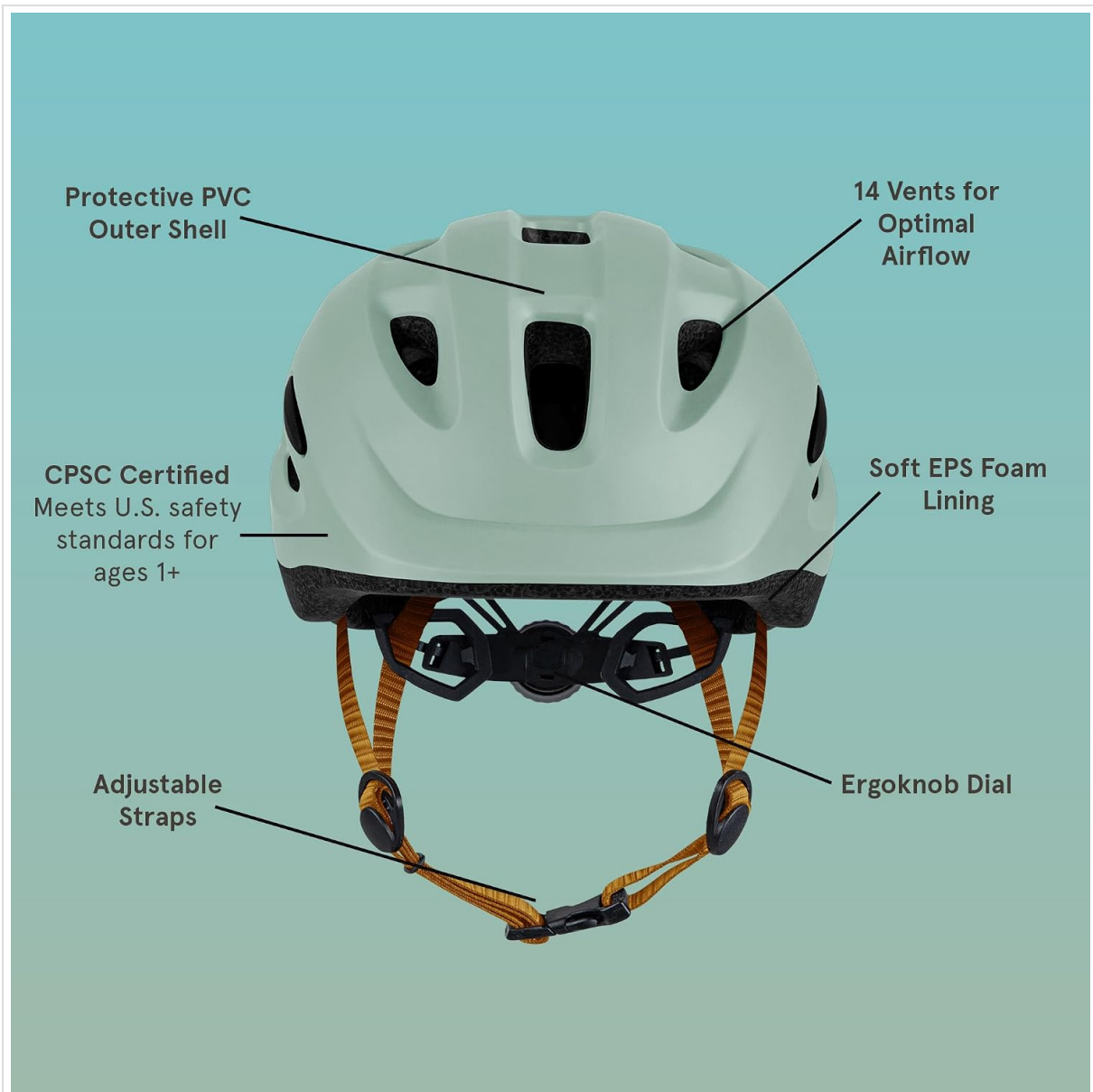

PRODUCT FEATURES

SETUP AND FITTING

A properly fitted helmet is crucial for effective protection. Follow these steps to ensure a correct fit:

1. Measure Head Circumference

Before adjusting the helmet, measure your child's head to select the correct size. Wrap a measuring tape around your child's head, just above their eyebrows. The tape should rest just above their ears and remain level around the circumference of their head.

Toddler Size: 17.75-19.25 inches (45-49 cm)

Kids Size: 19.25-20.5 inches (49-53 cm)

How to Measure Your Child's Helmet

Wrap a measuring tape around your child's head, just above their eyebrows. The tape should rest just above their ears and remain level around the circumference of their head.

2. Adjusting the Fit

1. **Placement:** Place the helmet squarely on your child's head, ensuring it covers the forehead without tilting back.
2. **ErgoKnob Dial:** Locate the ErgoKnob dial at the back of the helmet. Turn the dial clockwise to tighten the internal retention system until the helmet feels snug but comfortable. Turn counter-clockwise to loosen. The helmet should not move more than an inch in any direction when shaken.
3. **Adjustable Straps:** Adjust the nylon chin straps so that the buckles sit just below the ears, forming a "V" shape. The straps should be snug against the face.
4. **Chin Strap Buckle:** Fasten the chin strap buckle. There should be enough room to fit one or two fingers between the strap and your child's chin. The strap should be tight enough to prevent the helmet from rocking forward or backward.

PROPER USAGE

The Retrospec Scout helmet is designed for multi-sport protection. Ensure your child wears the helmet correctly for all applicable activities:

- Always wear the helmet when biking, scootering, skateboarding, or roller skating.
- Ensure the helmet is level on the head, covering the forehead. It should not be pushed back, exposing the forehead.
- The straps must be securely fastened, and the helmet should not wobble or shift during movement.
- Do not wear hats or other items under the helmet that could interfere with its fit or protective function.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care extends the life of your helmet and maintains its hygiene:

- **Cleaning:** The interior padding is removable and washable. Gently remove the pads and hand wash them with mild soap and water. Allow them to air dry completely before reinserting.
- **Shell Cleaning:** Clean the outer shell with a soft cloth, mild soap, and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the helmet material.
- **Storage:** Store the helmet in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Prolonged exposure to heat (e.g., inside a hot car) can damage the helmet's materials.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the helmet for any signs of damage, such as cracks in the shell or foam, frayed straps, or malfunctioning buckles. If any damage is found, replace the helmet immediately.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your helmet, consider the following:

- **Helmet feels loose:** Ensure the ErgoKnob dial is tightened sufficiently and the chin straps are snug. Refer to the "Adjusting the Fit" section.
- **Helmet is uncomfortable:** Check if the padding is correctly positioned. Ensure the helmet is not too tight. If discomfort persists, re-measure head circumference to confirm correct size.
- **Straps are twisted:** Unbuckle the straps and untwist them, then re-adjust according to the fitting instructions.
- **Helmet has been impacted:** Even if there is no visible damage, the helmet's protective integrity may be compromised. Replace the helmet immediately after any impact.
