1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the INALSA Steam Master Plus Standing Garment Steamer. This appliance is designed to provide efficient and gentle wrinkle removal for various fabrics, offering both vertical and horizontal steaming capabilities. Please read this instruction manual carefully before using the appliance to ensure safe operation and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet when filling or emptying the water tank, and when not in use.
- This appliance is equipped with **Dry Boiling Protection** and **Over-Heat Protection**, which automatically switch off the heating element if the water tank is empty or overheats.
- Use the appliance only for its intended household purpose as described in this manual.
- Keep the steam hose straight during operation to prevent kinks and ensure consistent steam flow.

- Do not direct steam at people, pets, or electrical appliances. Steam is hot and can cause burns.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.

1. **Powerful Steam Vents:** For effective steam distribution.
2. **2-Way Adjustment Iron Board:** Allows for both vertical and horizontal steaming positions.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your garment steamer before first use.

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Assemble Poles:** Insert the adjustable poles into the main unit base.
3. **Attach Hanger and Board:** Secure the garment hanger and adjustable iron board to the top of the poles.
4. **Connect Hose:** Attach the steam hose to the main unit. Ensure it is securely fastened.
5. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the 1.7 L detachable water tank. Fill it with clean, filtered water. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.

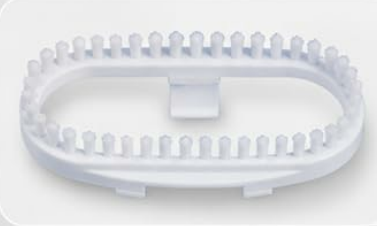

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to effectively use your INALSA Steam Master Plus Garment Steamer for wrinkle-free clothes.

A Garment Steamer Is Not a Replacement for a Steam Iron

Use the right tool for the right garment.

1. **Power On:** Plug the appliance into a suitable power outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Preheating:** The steamer will heat up in approximately 28 seconds. Wait for the steam to become consistent before beginning.
3. **Select Steam Setting:** Use the variable control knob to select the appropriate steam output (20-30 g/min) for your fabric type.
4. **Prepare Garment:** Hang the garment on the integrated hanger. For best results, ensure the garment is taut.
5. **Steaming:** Hold the steam nozzle a few inches away from the fabric and move it in a vertical, downward motion. For stubborn wrinkles, gently press the nozzle against the fabric.
6. **Vertical & Horizontal Steaming:** Utilize the adjustable 90° & 180° iron board position to comfortably steam clothes vertically or horizontally.
7. **Using Fabric Brush:** Attach the fabric brush for heavy embroidery and embellished fabrics to help lift fibers and remove lint.
8. **Post-Steaming:** Allow the garment to cool and dry completely before wearing or storing.
9. **Power Off:** Unplug the appliance from the power outlet after use.

Usage Tips:

- **Use RO / Filtered Water:** This helps reduce scaling and maintains smooth steam performance.
- **Keep the Hose Straight:** Avoid kinks in the hose to ensure steam flows freely and evenly.

1. **Prepare Solution:** Fill the water tank with 200ml water and 200ml white vinegar.
2. **Soak:** Reattach the tank and leave it for 8 hours to dissolve mineral build-up.
3. **Release Solution:** Locate the knob at the very bottom of the unit and release it to drain the solution.
4. **Rinse:** Refill with fresh water, run the steamer until dry, and then turn it off. Rinse the tank completely with fresh water before the next use to prevent any lingering odors.

Cleaning and Storage:

- Always unplug the steamer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank after each use.
- Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Store the steamer in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your steamer, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or low steam output	Water tank empty; Steamer not preheated; Hose kinked; Mineral build-up.	Fill water tank; Allow 28 seconds for preheating; Straighten hose; Perform descaling (Anti-Calc System).
Water leakage from nozzle	Hose not straight; Overfilling water tank; Condensation in hose.	Ensure hose is straight and elevated; Do not overfill tank; Allow steamer to heat fully before use.
Appliance not turning on	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Overheat protection activated.	Check power connection; Try a different outlet; Allow appliance to cool down.
