USER MANUAL

Product Overview

The Arafuna 10.5" Dual Portable Car DVD Player is designed to provide entertainment during car journeys, featuring two independent screens for flexible viewing options. It boasts a long-lasting rechargeable battery, wide media compatibility, and enhanced audio for an optimal user experience.

- **Long Battery Life:** Equipped with a 5000mAh rechargeable lithium battery, offering up to 5 hours of continuous playback for a single screen, or 2-3 hours when both screens are in use. Multiple power sources include the built-in battery, car charger, and AC adapter.
- **Independent Dual Screens:** Features two 10.5-inch HD screens that can display different movies simultaneously or mirror the same DVD content via a simple AV cable connection. An AV out port allows connection to a larger TV screen.
- **Wide Compatibility:** Supports region-free playback of DVDs, CDs, VCDs, SVCDs, CD±R, DVD±R, and DVD±RW discs (non-Blu-ray). Also compatible with USB drives and TF cards, supporting video formats like VOB, MPG, MPEG, AVI, FLV, DAT, DivX, and audio formats MP3, MP2 (max 32GB FAT32, 720*576 pixels). Includes a built-in last memory function to resume playback from where you left off.
- **Upgraded Dual Bottom Speakers:** Specially designed stereo speakers located at the bottom provide clearer audio and minimize sound interference for front passengers. The package includes two mounting brackets and straps for versatile headrest installation.

Setup

1. Headrest Installation

The Arafuna DVD players can be easily mounted to car headrests using the provided brackets and straps.

1. **Install the Base:** Attach the mounting base to the headrest posts.
2. **Tighten the Fixing Screws:** Secure the base firmly by tightening the screws.
3. **Insert:** Slide the DVD player onto the installed base until it clicks into place.
4. **Installation Completed:** Ensure the player is stable and securely mounted.

- **AC Adapter:** Connect the AC adapter to a standard wall outlet for home use or charging.

Operating Instructions

1. Basic Playback

To begin playback, open the disc tray, insert your DVD or CD, and close the tray. The player will automatically detect the disc and begin playback. For media from USB or TF card, insert the storage device into the corresponding port. Use the remote control or on-device buttons for navigation and playback control.

2. Dual Screen Modes

The Arafuna dual DVD player offers flexibility in how content is displayed across both screens.

PLAY THE SAME/DIFFERENT MOVIES

- **Share the Same Movie:** Connect the two players using the provided AV cable to mirror the content from the main player to the secondary screen.
- **Watch 2 Different Movies:** Each player can function independently, allowing two different movies to be watched simultaneously on separate screens.

3. Connecting to a Television

You can connect the DVD player to a larger television screen for an enhanced viewing experience using the AV out port.

Use the RCA cable to connect the AV OUT port on the DVD player to the AV IN ports on your television. Select the correct input source on your TV to display the content from the DVD player.

4. Last Memory Function

The built-in last memory function ensures that the player resumes playback from the exact point where it was last stopped, even after being powered off.

- **ON/OFF Switch:** Powers the device on or off.
- **OPEN Button:** Releases the disc tray.
- **DC IN 12V:** Power input for the main player.
- **DC OUT:** Power output to connect to the secondary player.
- **AV IN:** Audio/Video input for external sources.
- **TF CARD Slot:** For inserting TransFlash (microSD) cards.
- **AV OUT:** Audio/Video output to connect to a TV or secondary player.
- **EARPHONE Jack:** For connecting headphones.
- **USB Port:** For connecting USB flash drives.

Maintenance

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Arafuna DVD player.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the player. For the screen, use a screen-specific cleaning solution and a microfiber cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Disc Care:** Handle discs by their edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches. Store discs in their cases when not in use. Clean dirty discs with a soft, lint-free cloth, wiping from the center outwards.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the DVD player in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device regularly, even if not in active use.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Arafuna DVD player, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Player does not power on.	Low battery; power adapter not connected properly; power switch off.	Charge the battery; ensure power adapter is securely connected; turn on the power switch.
No disc detected / Disc error.	Disc is dirty, scratched, or incompatible format; disc inserted incorrectly.	Clean the disc; try a different disc; ensure disc is inserted correctly with label facing up. Verify disc format compatibility (non-Blu-ray).
No sound.	Volume too low; headphones connected; audio cable loose.	Increase volume; disconnect headphones if using speakers; check AV/RCA cable connections.
Picture distorted or no picture.	Video cable loose; incorrect TV input selected; disc issue.	Check AV/RCA cable connections; select correct input source on TV; try a different disc.
Remote control not working.	Batteries are dead or inserted incorrectly; obstacle between remote and player.	Replace remote batteries; ensure correct battery polarity; remove any obstacles.
