IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembling and using this bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The top bunk has a maximum weight recommendation of 600 pounds. The bottom bunk also supports up to 600 pounds.
- **Age Restriction:** The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Guardrails:** Ensure all guardrails are properly installed and secured. The top bunk features a 12.4-inch high safety rail to prevent accidental falls.
- **Mattress:** Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions for each bunk. Ensure the mattress thickness on the top bunk does not exceed the height of the guardrails.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the provided ladders for climbing to and from the top bunk. Ensure ladders are securely attached.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight.

- Assembly tools (usually an Allen wrench)




Image: The metal frame of the bunk bed partially assembled, showing the robust construction and slat system.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps prolong the life of your bunk bed and ensures continued safety.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain stability and prevent squeaking.
- **Slat Inspection:** Ensure all bed slats are properly seated and secured. The plastic guardrails on the slats are designed to prevent noise from shifting.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all parts are correctly aligned.
Squeaking noises during use.	Loose connections or shifting slats.	Tighten all hardware. Verify that bed slats are properly positioned and the plastic guardrails are intact.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty assembling a part.	Incorrect orientation or missing hardware.	Refer to the assembly manual for correct orientation. Ensure all required hardware is present and used correctly. Do not force parts.
