ADDIESDIVE Automatic NH35 Wrist Watch Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the ADDIESDIVE Automatic NH35 Wrist Watch. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your timepiece. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ADDIESDIVE AD2048 is an automatic mechanical watch featuring a reliable NH35 movement, 200 meters of water resistance, and a luminous dial for enhanced readability in low light conditions. It combines classic design with robust functionality.

SETUP

1. Initial Winding

Your ADDIESDIVE watch is powered by an automatic mechanical movement. If the watch has stopped, it needs to be manually wound to initiate operation. To do this, unscrew the crown (if it's a screw-down crown) and turn it clockwise approximately 20-30 times. This will build up a power reserve to start the watch.

2. Setting the Time and Date

1. **Unscrew the Crown:** If your watch has a screw-down crown, gently unscrew it counter-clockwise until it pops out to position 0.
2. **Set the Date (Position 1):** Pull the crown out to the first click (Position 1). Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise (depending on the movement) to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement. If the current time falls within this window, adjust the time outside this range first.
3. **Set the Time (Position 2):** Pull the crown out to the second click (Position 2). Turn the crown to set the hour and minute hands. To ensure correct AM/PM, advance the hands past 12 o'clock; if the date changes, you are in PM. Continue setting the time.
4. **Push and Screw Down the Crown:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into Position 0 and screw it down clockwise firmly to ensure water resistance.

3. Strap Adjustment

The watch comes with a leather strap and a buckle clasp. Adjust the strap to a comfortable fit on your wrist, ensuring it is not too tight or too loose. The buckle should sit centrally on the underside of your wrist.

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Automatic Movement (NH35)

Your watch is equipped with a Japanese Automatic NH35 movement. This movement is self-winding, meaning it gains power from the motion of your wrist. When worn regularly, it will maintain its power reserve. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it may stop and require manual winding as described in the "Initial Winding" section.

Water Resistance (200 Meters)

The ADDIESDIVE AD2048 watch is water-resistant up to 200 meters (20 ATM). This makes it suitable for swimming, snorkeling, and recreational diving. Ensure the crown is always fully screwed down before any water exposure. Do not operate the crown or pushers while the watch is submerged in water.

Luminous Dial

The watch features a luminous dial and hands, allowing for easy readability in low-light conditions. The luminous material charges by absorbing light and then emits it in the dark. The intensity and duration of the glow depend on the exposure to light.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth regularly to remove dust and fingerprints. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Water Exposure

After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch thoroughly with fresh water and dry it completely with a soft cloth. This prevents salt buildup and corrosion. Always ensure the crown is screwed down before rinsing.

Strap Care

The leather strap should be kept dry and clean. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and moisture, as these can cause the leather to crack, fade, or deteriorate. If the strap gets wet, allow it to air dry naturally,

away from direct heat.

Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original box or a watch case. Keep it away from strong magnetic fields (e.g., speakers, refrigerators, certain electronic devices) as magnetism can affect the accuracy of mechanical movements.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** If the watch has stopped, manually wind it by turning the crown clockwise 20-30 times. If it still does not start, ensure the crown is pushed in and screwed down.
- **Inaccurate Time:** Mechanical watches can experience slight variations in accuracy. If your watch is consistently running too fast or too slow beyond acceptable limits (typically +/- 20 seconds per day for an NH35 movement), it may require adjustment by a professional watchmaker. Exposure to strong magnetic fields can also affect accuracy; demagnetization may be necessary.
- **Date Not Changing:** Ensure the time is set correctly for AM/PM. The date typically changes around midnight. If the date is stuck, try manually advancing the time past midnight to see if it corrects. If not, check the crown position for date adjustment.
- **Water Inside Watch:** If you notice condensation or water inside the watch, immediately take it to a qualified watchmaker for inspection and repair. Do not attempt to open the watch yourself, as this will void the warranty and can cause further damage.
