Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Escape Wireless Stereo Headphones, Model BTAC866. These headphones utilize advanced air conduction technology to provide clear audio while allowing you to remain aware of your surroundings. Designed for comfort and convenience, they feature intuitive touch controls and a built-in microphone for hands-free calls. This manual provides instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance of your device.

Key Features:

- **Air Conduction Technology:** Delivers sound without blocking the ear canal, maintaining situational awareness.
- **Touch Controls:** Intuitive controls for music playback and call management.
- **Built-in Microphone:** Enables clear hands-free calls.
- **Bluetooth Connectivity:** Seamless wireless pairing with compatible devices.
- **Open Concept Design:** Provides comfort for extended wear.

Setup

1. Charging the Headphones

1. Locate the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the supplied USB charging cable to the headphones and a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator will illuminate to show charging status. It will typically turn off or change color once fully charged.
4. Allow approximately 1-2 hours for a full charge before first use.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. **Power On:** Press and hold the touch control area on the headphones until the LED indicator flashes, usually blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
2. **Activate Bluetooth:** On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), go to the Bluetooth settings and ensure Bluetooth is enabled.
3. **Select Device:** In the list of available Bluetooth devices, locate and select "Escape BTAC866" (or similar name).
4. **Confirm Connection:** Once paired, the LED indicator on the headphones will typically show a solid blue light or flash slowly. A voice prompt may also confirm the connection.
5. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

Note: The headphones will automatically attempt to reconnect to the last paired device when powered on.

Operating Instructions

The Escape BTAC866 headphones feature intuitive touch controls. The specific touch gestures may vary slightly, but common functions are listed below.

Function	Action
Power On	Press and hold the touch control area for approximately 3 seconds.
Power Off	Press and hold the touch control area for approximately 5 seconds.
Play/Pause Music	Single tap the touch control area.
Next Track	Double tap the right earbud's touch control area.
Previous Track	Double tap the left earbud's touch control area.
Volume Up	Triple tap the right earbud's touch control area.
Volume Down	Triple tap the left earbud's touch control area.
Answer/End Call	Single tap the touch control area during an incoming call or active call.
Reject Call	Press and hold the touch control area for 2 seconds during an incoming call.
Activate Voice Assistant	Press and hold the touch control area for 2 seconds (when not on a call).

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Water Exposure:** These headphones are not waterproof. Avoid exposure to water or excessive moisture.
- **Charging:** Charge the headphones regularly, even if not in use, to maintain battery health.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (LED flashing blue/red). Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. Move headphones closer to your device. Forget "Escape BTAC866" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again. Restart both the headphones and your device.
No sound or low volume.	Ensure headphones are connected to your device. Adjust volume on both the headphones and your connected device. Check if the audio output on your device is set to "Escape BTAC866".
Call quality is poor.	Ensure the microphone is not obstructed. Move to an area with less environmental noise. Check your device's network signal.
