SONICAKE QDT-30 Hydraulic Height Adjustable Drum Throne Instruction Manual

Model: QDT-30

INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective assembly, operation, and maintenance of your SONICAKE QDT-30 Hydraulic Height Adjustable Drum Throne. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- Always ensure all components are securely fastened before use. Improper assembly can lead to instability and potential injury.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 440 lbs (200 kg). Exceeding this limit may cause damage to the product or personal injury.
- Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts during height adjustment.
- Use the drum throne on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Regularly inspect the drum throne for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components. Discontinue use if any issues are found and contact customer support.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all the following components are included in your package:

- 1x Seat Cushion (with hydraulic lever attached)
- 1x Backrest
- 1x Hydraulic Base/Stand Assembly (with legs and anti-slip feet)
- 2x Backrest Attachment Screws
- 2x Washers

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your drum throne:

- 1. Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and place them on a clean, flat surface. Refer to the "Package Contents" section to ensure all parts are present.
- 2. Attach Backrest to Seat:**
 - Locate the mounting bracket on the underside of the seat cushion and the corresponding attachment point on the backrest.
 - Align the backrest with the bracket.
 - Insert the two backrest attachment screws through the washers and then through the bracket holes into the backrest. Tighten securely by hand. Do not overtighten.

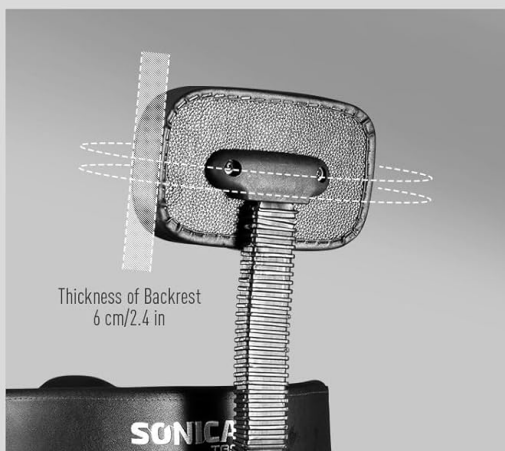


Image: Close-up view of the backrest attachment point on the underside of the seat, showing the screws and mechanism for securing the backrest.

3. Attach Seat Assembly to Hydraulic Base:

- Place the hydraulic base/stand on a stable surface with the legs fully extended.
- Carefully place the assembled seat (with backrest) onto the top of the hydraulic cylinder of the base. Ensure it is seated firmly and centrally.

4. **Verify Stability:** Gently test the stability of the assembled drum throne before sitting on it. Ensure all connections are tight and the base legs are fully spread.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Height Adjustment

The SONICAKE QDT-30 features a hydraulic mechanism for quick and effortless height adjustment.

- **To Raise the Seat:** While standing, pull the hydraulic lever located under the seat upwards. The seat will automatically rise. Release the lever when the desired height is reached.
- **To Lower the Seat:** While seated, pull the hydraulic lever upwards. The seat will lower under your body weight. Release the lever when the desired height is reached.

The adjustable height range is approximately 45 cm (17.7 inches) to 60 cm (23.6 inches).

Backrest Adjustment

The backrest can be adjusted for optimal ergonomic support.

- **To Adjust Backrest Position:** Loosen the backrest attachment screws located on the underside of the seat. Adjust the backrest forwards or backwards to your preferred position. Once adjusted, securely tighten the screws to lock the backrest in place.
- The backrest is designed to conform to the natural curvature of the human body, providing excellent lumbar support.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the leather fabric seat and backrest with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn stains, use a mild soap solution and dry thoroughly. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and bolts, especially those securing the backrest and the seat to the base, to ensure they remain tight. Tighten if necessary.
- **Hydraulic System:** The hydraulic system is generally maintenance-free. If you notice any issues with height adjustment, ensure the lever is functioning correctly and there are no obstructions.
- **Anti-slip Feet:** Ensure the anti-slip rubber pads on the base legs are clean and free from debris to maintain optimal grip.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Seat does not raise or lower smoothly.	Hydraulic lever stuck or obstructed; hydraulic cylinder issue.	Check if the hydraulic lever moves freely. Ensure no obstructions are preventing movement. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Drum throne feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose assembly screws; uneven surface; damaged base.	Ensure all assembly screws (especially backrest and seat-to-base connections) are securely tightened. Verify the drum throne is on a flat, level surface. Inspect the base legs for any damage.
Backrest moves or feels loose.	Backrest attachment screws are loose.	Tighten the backrest attachment screws firmly.


