3.1 Front View

- **7-inch IPS HD Touchscreen:** The primary display for all interactions.
- **Front Camera (2.0MP):** Located at the top center for video calls and selfies.

3.2 Rear View

- **Rear Camera (5.0MP):** For capturing photos and videos.
- **Speaker:** Audio output.




Image: The ZZB Tablet highlighting its 2.0MP front camera and 5.0MP back camera for high-definition capture.

3.3 Side View (Ports and Buttons)

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off, short press to sleep/wake.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust audio volume.
- **USB Port:** For charging and data transfer.
- **MicroSD Card Slot:** For expandable storage.
- **Headphone Jack:** For connecting wired headphones.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Tablet

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the tablet's USB port.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a compatible USB power adapter (not included) and plug it into a wall outlet.
3. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status. Allow the tablet to fully charge before first

use.

4.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the ZZB logo appears on the screen.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the power options appear, then select "Power Off".
- **To Sleep/Wake:** Short press the Power button.

4.3 Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, the tablet will guide you through the initial setup process:

1. Select your preferred language.
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
3. Accept the terms and conditions.
4. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is necessary to download apps from the Google Play Store.
5. Follow any remaining on-screen prompts to complete the setup.

4.4 Inserting a MicroSD Card

To expand the tablet's storage, you can insert a MicroSD card (up to 1024GB).

1. Locate the MicroSD card slot on the side of the tablet.
2. Gently insert the MicroSD card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
3. The tablet will detect the card and may prompt you to format it for use. Follow the on-screen instructions.




Image: The ZB Tablet highlighting its 4GB RAM and 32GB internal storage, which can be expanded with a MicroSD card.

5. OPERATING YOUR TABLET

5.1 Basic Navigation

The ZB Tablet uses a capacitive touchscreen for interaction:

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Tap & Hold:** Access contextual menus or move icons.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through pages or lists.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.

5.2 Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**.
2. Toggle Wi-Fi to **On**.
3. Select your desired network from the list.

4. Enter the password if prompted, then tap **Connect**.

5.3 Using Bluetooth

1. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
2. Toggle Bluetooth to **On**.
3. The tablet will scan for available devices. Select the device you wish to pair with and follow the on-screen instructions.

5.4 Using the Cameras

The tablet features a 2MP front camera and a 5MP rear camera.

1. Open the **Camera** app.
2. Tap the camera icon to switch between front and rear cameras.
3. Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start/stop video recording.

5.5 Managing Storage

Your tablet has 32GB of internal storage, expandable via MicroSD card.

- To view storage usage, go to **Settings > Storage**.
- You can move files to the MicroSD card to free up internal space.

5.6 Installing and Uninstalling Apps

Apps can be downloaded from the Google Play Store.

- **Install:** Open the **Play Store** app, search for the desired app, and tap **Install**.
- **Uninstall:** Tap and hold the app icon on the home screen or app drawer, then drag it to "Uninstall" or select "App info" and tap "Uninstall". Alternatively, go to **Settings > Apps > select the app > Uninstall**.

5.7 Battery Management

To optimize battery life:

- Adjust screen brightness.
- Turn off Wi-Fi and Bluetooth when not in use.
- Close unused apps running in the background.
- Enable battery saver mode in **Settings** > **Battery**.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning Your Tablet

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body.
- Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Avoid getting moisture into ports.

6.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features and security patches.

1. Connect your tablet to a Wi-Fi network.
2. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install any available updates.

6.3 Storage Optimization

To maintain optimal performance, regularly manage your tablet's storage:

- Delete unnecessary apps and files.
- Clear cache data for apps in **Settings > Apps > select app > Storage & cache > Clear cache**.
- Transfer large files (photos, videos) to your MicroSD card or cloud storage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your tablet, try the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
Tablet does not turn on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again.
Slow performance / Lags	Close unused apps. Clear app cache. Restart the tablet. Check for software updates. Consider a factory reset if issues persist.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network and reconnect.
Apps crashing	Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps). Uninstall and reinstall the app. Ensure the tablet's software is up to date.
Battery drains quickly	Reduce screen brightness. Disable Wi-Fi/Bluetooth when not in use. Close background apps. Check battery usage in Settings to identify power-hungry apps.
Screen unresponsive	Restart the tablet. If the issue persists, contact customer support.

7.1 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data on your tablet and restore it to its original factory settings. Back up important data before proceeding.

1. Go to **Settings > System > Reset options**.
2. Select **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
3. Confirm your choice and follow the on-screen prompts.
