1. Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Trade Shop FO-85011 CID Big Button Corded Telephone. Please read this manual carefully before using the telephone to ensure proper functionality and to familiarize yourself with all features.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1x Handset
- 1x Coiled Handset Cord
- 1x Telephone Line Cord

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Connecting the Handset

- 1. Locate the coiled handset cord.
- 2. Plug one end of the coiled cord into the jack on the side of the telephone base, marked with a handset icon.
- 3. Plug the other end of the coiled cord into the jack at the bottom of the handset.

3.2 Connecting to the Telephone Line

- 1. Locate the telephone line cord.
- 2. Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the jack on the back or side of the telephone base, typically marked with a wall jack icon.
- 3. Plug the other end of the telephone line cord into your wall telephone jack.

3.3 Initial Check

After connecting both cords, lift the handset. You should hear a dial tone. If not, please refer to the Troubleshooting section.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Making a Call

- 1. Lift the handset.
- 2. Wait for a dial tone.
- 3. Dial the desired telephone number using the large numeric keypad. The number will appear on the integrated display.
- 4. Wait for the call to connect.

4.2 Receiving a Call

- 1. When the telephone rings, lift the handset to answer the call.
- 2. To end the call, place the handset back into its cradle.

4.3 Redial Function

To redial the last number called:

- 1. Lift the handset.
- 2. Press the **REDIAL** button. The telephone will automatically dial the last number.

4.4 Flash/BRT Button

The **FLASH/BRT** button is used for specific telephone system features, such as call waiting or transferring calls, depending on your telephone service provider. Consult your service provider for details on its functionality.

4.5 Integrated Calculator Function

The telephone includes a basic calculator function:

- 1. To activate the calculator, press the designated calculator button (if available, otherwise consult the display for an option).
- 2. Use the numeric keypad to input numbers and perform calculations.
- 3. The results will be displayed on the integrated screen.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the telephone's surface. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as they may damage the finish.
- **Storage:** Store the telephone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use for extended periods.
- **Liquid Exposure:** Do not expose the telephone to water or other liquids. If liquid enters the unit, disconnect it immediately and contact support.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your telephone, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• No Dial Tone:

- Ensure all cables (handset cord and telephone line cord) are securely connected.
- Test the wall telephone jack with another working phone to confirm the line is active.
- Check for any service outages with your telephone service provider.

• Display Not Working:

- Ensure the telephone is properly connected to the active telephone line, as some displays draw power from the line.
- If the display requires batteries (not specified for this model, but common for CID features), check and replace them if necessary.

• Cannot Make or Receive Calls:

- Verify the telephone line connection.
- Confirm that your telephone service is active.
- Ensure the handset is properly seated in the cradle when not in use.
