## Introduction

Designed for versatility and convenience, this grill cart is compatible with 17-inch and 22-inch Blackstone and Ninja griddles, as well as other portable outdoor cooking equipment. - **Enhanced Portability:** Equipped with flexible wheels and ergonomic handles for easy movement. The foldable design allows for compact storage and transport.
- **Ample Storage:** Features a bottom shelf designed to hold a 20-pound gas cylinder, along with 4 multi-function hooks, a knife holder, a tissue box, and bottle openers for an organized outdoor prep station.
- **User-Friendly Assembly:** Designed for straightforward assembly with minimal maintenance requirements.

## Setup Instructions

Your Leteuke Grill Cart is designed for quick and easy setup. Follow these steps to prepare your cart for use:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage during transit.
2. **Unfolding the Frame:** Gently unfold the main frame of the grill cart. Ensure all locking mechanisms (if any) are securely engaged to provide a stable base.

3. **Attaching the Bottom Shelf:** Position the bottom shelf into its designated slots. Secure it using the provided wing nuts or fasteners. This shelf is designed to hold a 20-pound propane tank securely.
4. **Installing Side Accessories:** Attach the removable handle to the designated points. Install the collapsible spice rack, paper towel holder, and multi-function hooks as desired.
5. **Placing the Grill:** Carefully place your 17-inch or 22-inch griddle, Ninja grill, Ooni pizza oven, or other compatible cooking equipment onto the carbon steel tabletop. Ensure it is centered and stable.
6. **Connecting Propane (if applicable):** Connect your propane tank to your cooking appliance, routing the hose safely to avoid kinks or contact with hot surfaces.

*Note: Some components like the side table and seasoning tray may need to be detached for compact storage and reattached for use. Ensure all connections are secure before operation.*

## Operating Instructions

- **Positioning the Cart:** Use the flexible wheels to move the cart to your desired cooking location. Engage the locking brakes on the wheels to ensure stability during use.
- **Utilizing Prep Space:** The main tabletop and the extended side shelf provide ample space for food preparation, utensils, and ingredients. The non-slip, heat-insulating mat on the main surface helps protect the tabletop and keeps your grill secure.
- **Accessing Storage:** Use the bottom shelf for your propane tank and other larger items. The integrated spice rack, knife holder, and hooks keep your cooking essentials within easy reach.
- **Safety First:** Always ensure your cooking appliance is properly connected and stable on the cart. Keep flammable materials away from heat sources.

## Maintenance

Regular maintenance will prolong the life and appearance of your grill cart:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe down the carbon steel surfaces with a damp cloth to remove food residue and grease. For stubborn stains, use a mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Drying:** Ensure all metal parts are thoroughly dried after cleaning to prevent rust.
- **Storage:** For long-term storage or transport, the grill cart can be folded compactly. Detach any removable accessories (side shelf, spice rack, handle) and store them in the provided bag. Store the folded cart in a dry, sheltered area.
- **Wheel Care:** Periodically check the wheels for debris and ensure they roll smoothly. Lubricate if necessary.

## Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Propane tank does not fit in the bottom holder.	Older version of the cart or tank size incompatibility.	Ensure you have the correct 20-pound tank. If issues persist, contact customer support for potential updated parts or alternative solutions.
Cart is wobbly or unstable.	Legs not fully extended/locked, or wheels not locked.	Ensure all legs are fully extended and their locking mechanisms are engaged. Lock all four wheels before use.
Accessories (spice rack, paper towel holder) are in the way during cooking.	Placement preference.	These accessories are removable. Adjust their position or remove them if they interfere with your cooking workflow. Consider reorienting the griddle if possible.
Difficulty with assembly/disassembly.	Missing instructions or unfamiliarity with folding mechanisms.	Refer to the detailed setup instructions in this manual. Ensure all wing nuts and fasteners are correctly used. Practice folding/unfolding a few times.
