1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Forbes Wet & Dry Zeal Vacuum Cleaner. This versatile appliance is designed for both wet and dry cleaning tasks, offering powerful suction and a convenient blower function. With its compact size and 7-liter capacity, it is suitable for various surfaces including sofas, carpets, floors, and car interiors. Please read this manual carefully before operating the appliance to ensure safe and efficient use.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using this vacuum cleaner.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- To reduce the risk of electric shock, do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use without dust bag and/or filters in place.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your vacuum cleaner:

- **Motor Head:** Contains the motor, power switch, and blower port.
- **Collection Tank:** 7-liter capacity tank for collecting dust and liquids.
- **Hose Inlet:** Where the flexible hose connects for vacuuming.
- **Blower Port:** Where the flexible hose connects for blower function.
- **Filters:** Includes a washable HEPA filter for dry use and a foam filter for wet use.
- **Swivel Wheels:** Four 360° swivel wheels for easy maneuverability.
- **Handle:** Integrated handle on the motor head for portability.

5. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Attaching Wheels:** Insert the four swivel wheels into the designated slots on the bottom of the collection tank until they click into place.
3. **Filter Installation:**
 - For **Dry Vacuuming:** Ensure the HEPA filter is securely installed over the motor head.
 - For **Wet Vacuuming:** Remove the HEPA filter and install the foam filter. The foam filter protects the motor from liquids.
4. **Assembling Hose and Attachments:**
 - Connect the flexible hose to the suction inlet on the front of the collection tank for vacuuming.
 - Attach the desired extension wands and cleaning nozzle (e.g., floor nozzle, crevice tool) to the end of the hose.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Dry Vacuuming

1. Ensure the HEPA filter is correctly installed.
2. Connect the flexible hose to the suction inlet.
3. Attach the appropriate dry cleaning accessory (e.g., floor nozzle for hard floors/carpets, brush tool for upholstery, crevice tool for tight spaces).
4. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet (220 Volts).
5. Press the power button to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
6. Move the nozzle over the surface to be cleaned. The powerful 16KPa suction will collect dust and debris.
7. After use, press the power button to turn off the appliance and unplug it.

6.2 Wet Vacuuming

Important: Before wet vacuuming, ensure the HEPA filter is removed and the foam filter is installed. Failure to do so can damage the motor.

1. Remove the HEPA filter and install the foam filter.
2. Connect the flexible hose to the suction inlet.
3. Attach the floor nozzle or appropriate wet cleaning accessory.
4. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
5. Press the power button to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
6. Carefully vacuum up liquid spills. The tank has a 7-liter capacity for liquids.
7. The vacuum cleaner has a float mechanism that will automatically shut off suction when the tank is full to prevent overfilling. If this occurs, turn off the vacuum, unplug it, and empty the tank.

8. After use, press the power button to turn off the appliance and unplug it. Empty and clean the tank immediately after wet use.

Comes with a 7 Liter dust tank (easily emptiable) that ensures uninterrupted cleaning.

6.3 Blower Function

1. Ensure the collection tank is empty and clean.
2. Connect the flexible hose to the blower port located on the motor head.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
4. Press the power button to turn on the vacuum cleaner. Air will now be expelled from the hose.
5. Use the blower function to clear dust from hard-to-reach areas like window channels, sofa corners, or to dry wet surfaces.
6. After use, press the power button to turn off the appliance and unplug it.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner.

7.1 Emptying the Collection Tank

1. Always unplug the vacuum cleaner before emptying.
2. Unlatch the clips securing the motor head to the collection tank.
3. Carefully lift off the motor head.
4. Dispose of dry debris or pour out liquids from the tank.
5. Rinse the tank with water if necessary and dry thoroughly before reassembling.

7.2 Cleaning Filters

- **HEPA Filter (for Dry Use):** Remove the HEPA filter from the motor head. Tap it gently to dislodge dust. If heavily soiled, rinse under running water. Ensure it is completely dry before reinstallation.
- **Foam Filter (for Wet Use):** Remove the foam filter. Rinse thoroughly with water and allow it to air dry completely before storing or reusing.

Note: Never operate the vacuum cleaner without the appropriate filter installed.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	No power supply; Power switch off; Damaged cord/plug.	Check power outlet; Ensure switch is ON; Inspect cord/plug for damage (contact service if damaged).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low suction power.	Full collection tank; Clogged hose/nozzle; Dirty filter; Improperly sealed motor head.	Empty tank; Clear obstructions; Clean/replace filter; Ensure motor head is latched securely.
Water leaking from tank.	Tank overfilled; Improperly installed foam filter; Damaged tank seal.	Empty tank; Check foam filter installation; Contact service for seal replacement.
Motor overheats and shuts off.	Blocked airflow; Prolonged continuous use.	Check for blockages in hose/nozzle/filter. Allow unit to cool down for 30 minutes before restarting.
