3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

 - **USB Power:** Connect the USB cable to a 5V power source such as a power bank, wall charger, USB-socket, or laptop.
 - **Battery Box:** Alternatively, insert the required batteries (not included) into the battery box and connect it to the remote control module.
7. **Test Lights:** Before finalizing placement, briefly power on the system to ensure all lights are functioning correctly.

- **Storage:** If storing the LEGO model with the light kit, ensure it is kept in a dry, dust-free environment away from extreme temperatures.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lights do not turn on.	No power, loose connection, dead batteries.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure USB power source is active or batteries are correctly installed and charged. ◦ Check all cable connections to the remote control module and individual LEDs. ◦ Verify the remote control module is properly connected to the power source.
Some lights are not working.	Loose connection, faulty LED.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Inspect connections for the non-functioning lights. ◦ If a specific LED is faulty, contact customer support for assistance.
Remote control not responding.	Remote battery dead, obstruction, remote not paired.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Replace the battery in the remote control handset. ◦ Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the module. ◦ Refer to the online installation guide for remote pairing instructions if necessary.
