1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your PLANTKA Original Clean Water Tank. This component is designed to be fully compatible with Midea G6 Pro, G7, X10 Pro, and X10 Plus cordless handheld vacuum cleaners, ensuring optimal cleaning performance.

The clean water tank is a crucial part of your vacuum cleaner's mopping function, allowing it to deliver water for effective floor cleaning. Made from high-strength and environmentally friendly materials, this tank is built for durability and seamless integration with your existing equipment.

2. Setup and Installation

Installing the clean water tank is a straightforward process designed for routine maintenance.

- 1. Identify the Water Tank Slot:** Locate the designated slot for the clean water tank on your Midea G6 Pro/G7/X10 Pro/X10 Plus vacuum cleaner. Refer to your vacuum cleaner's main manual if unsure.
- 2. Align the Tank:** Carefully align the new clean water tank with the slot, ensuring the connectors and guides match.
- 3. Secure in Place:** Gently push the tank into the slot until it clicks securely into position. Ensure there is no gap and the tank feels firmly attached.

3. Operating Instructions

Once the clean water tank is installed, it enables the mopping functionality of your vacuum cleaner.

1. **Fill the Tank:** Open the designated filling port on the clean water tank. Fill it with clean tap water. If your vacuum cleaner supports it, you may add a small amount of compatible, non-foaming cleaning solution as per your vacuum cleaner's instructions. Do not overfill.
2. **Close the Port:** Securely close the filling port to prevent leaks during operation.
3. **Operate Vacuum Cleaner:** Turn on your Midea vacuum cleaner and select the appropriate cleaning mode that utilizes the mopping function. The vacuum cleaner will draw water from the tank as needed for floor cleaning.

4. Maintenance

Regular maintenance of your clean water tank ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

Cleaning the Water Tank

1. **Remove the Tank:** Detach the clean water tank from the vacuum cleaner by reversing the installation steps.
2. **Empty Contents:** Pour out any remaining water or cleaning solution from the tank.
3. **Rinse Thoroughly:** Rinse the inside of the tank with clean tap water to remove any residue. You may use a soft brush if necessary to clean hard-to-reach areas.
4. **Air Dry:** Allow the tank to air dry completely before re-installing or storing it. This prevents mold and mildew growth.

Replacement Schedule

For best results and to maintain peak cleaning efficiency, it is recommended to replace the clean water tank every 2 to 3 months, or sooner if visible damage or wear occurs. Refer to the 'Setup and Installation' section for instructions on installing a new tank.

5. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your clean water tank, consider the following common problems and solutions:

- **Water Leakage:**
 - Ensure the tank is correctly installed and fully seated in the vacuum cleaner.
 - Check that the filling port cap is securely closed.
 - Inspect the tank for any cracks or damage. If damaged, replacement is necessary.
- **No Water Dispensing:**

- Verify that the tank is filled with water.
 - Confirm the tank is properly installed and making full contact with the vacuum cleaner's water delivery system.
 - Ensure your vacuum cleaner is in a mode that utilizes the mopping function.
- **Reduced Cleaning Performance:**
 - Clean the water tank regularly to prevent blockages from residue.
 - Consider replacing the tank if it is old or shows signs of wear, as per the recommended replacement schedule.
