INTRODUCTION

The TOPTRO TR26 Mini Projector is a portable, high-definition projector designed for home and outdoor entertainment. It supports 4K and 1080P Full HD content, offering a large screen display of up to 200 inches. Featuring automatic keystone correction, WiFi 6, and Bluetooth 5.2 connectivity, it provides a versatile and immersive viewing experience. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting.

SETUP

1. **Placement:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. The included tripod can be used for optimal positioning. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the projector.
2. **Power Connection:** Connect the power cord to the projector's power input and then to a power outlet.
3. **Initial Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn on the device.
4. **Focus Adjustment:** Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens until the projected image is clear and sharp.
5. **Keystone Correction:** The TR26 features automatic vertical keystone correction ($\pm 30^\circ$). For manual adjustment or fine-tuning, navigate to the 'Setting' menu using the remote control.
6. **Screen Size Adjustment:** The projector supports an 80% zoom function. Use the remote control to adjust the projected image size to fit your screen or wall.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Connectivity Options

The TOPTRO TR26 offers multiple ways to connect your devices:

- **HDMI:** Connect devices like TV sticks, gaming consoles (PS5), laptops, or PCs using an HDMI cable. Select 'HDMI' input from the projector's main menu.
- **USB:** Insert USB sticks to play media files directly. Select 'Media' from the main menu to browse files.
- **Audio Output (3.5mm):** Connect external speakers or headphones for enhanced audio experience.

Wireless Screen Mirroring (WiFi 6)

The projector supports 5G/2.4G dual-band WiFi 6 for smooth wireless screen mirroring from iOS, Android, and Windows devices.

1. Ensure your mobile device and the projector are connected to the same WiFi network.
2. On the projector's main menu, select 'Wireless Screen'.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions specific to your device (iOS/Android/Windows) to initiate screen mirroring.

Note on Copyrighted Content:

Due to HDCP copyright protection, direct screen mirroring from apps like Netflix, Prime Video, Disney+, etc., is not supported. For streaming copyrighted content, it is recommended to use an external streaming device such as an Amazon Fire TV Stick or Google Chromecast TV stick connected via HDMI. The TR26 mini projector also does not support Dolby sound effects; please ensure Dolby sound is turned off on your source device if experiencing audio issues.

Bluetooth 5.2 Connection

Connect Bluetooth headphones or speakers for an enhanced audio experience.

1. On the projector's main menu, select 'Bluetooth'.
2. Ensure your Bluetooth audio device is in pairing mode.
3. Select your device from the list of available devices on the projector screen to connect.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your projector. The advanced LED light source lamp has a lifespan of up to 30,000 hours.

Cleaning the Inner Screen (Removing Black Spots)

If you notice black spots on your projected image, it may be due to dust on the inner screen. Follow these steps to clean it:

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Ensure the projector is turned off and unplugged from the power source before proceeding.
2. **Access Dust Screen Cover:** Gently turn the projector bottom up. Locate the dust screen cover on the underside.
3. **Pry Off Cover:** Use a narrow and thin tool (like a small screwdriver or the provided cleaning tool) to carefully pry off the dust screen cover.
4. **Clean Inner Screen:** Use a clean cotton swab to gently clean the inner screen (there are typically three panels

inside).

5. **Verify Cleaning:** Turn on the projector and observe the screen to confirm that the dust spots have been removed.
6. **Replace Cover:** After cleaning, gently cover the dust screen cover back into place.

General Cleaning

- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the projector.
- For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution to avoid scratches.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No image or blurry image	Check power connection. Adjust focus ring. Perform keystone correction. Ensure input source is correctly selected.
No sound	Check volume levels on projector and source device. Ensure external speakers/headphones are properly connected or paired via Bluetooth. If using a streaming device, ensure Dolby sound is turned off.
Cannot screen mirror Netflix/Prime Video	Due to HDCP copyright protection, direct screen mirroring of these apps is not supported. Use an external streaming stick (e.g., Amazon Fire TV Stick, Google Chromecast) connected via HDMI.
Black spots on projected image	Dust on the inner screen. Refer to the "Cleaning the Inner Screen" section for instructions.




Image: Visual comparison highlighting the TR26's higher resolution and brightness.
