


Figure 1: Overview of the ROTORS Pool Skimmer Net. This image displays the skimmer net's design, featuring a sturdy handle and a fine mesh net, with an inset showing it effectively collecting leaves from a pool surface.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking

2.2 Assembly (If Applicable)

The ROTORS Pool Skimmer Net is designed for immediate use and typically does not require complex assembly. It features an integrated handle. For extended reach, the handle is designed to connect to most standard telescopic pool poles (pole not included). To attach:

1. Align the end of your telescopic pool pole with the opening at the end of the skimmer net's handle.
2. Push the pole firmly into the handle until it clicks into place or is securely seated.
3. Ensure the connection is stable before use.

3. OPERATION

3.1 Basic Usage

The ROTORS Pool Skimmer Net is designed for easy and efficient debris removal. Follow these steps for optimal performance:

1. **Submerge the Net:** Gently lower the skimmer net into the water, ensuring the entire mesh is submerged beneath the surface.
2. **Sweep Motion:** Use a smooth, sweeping motion to guide the net through the water, collecting leaves, insects, and other floating debris. For best results, sweep from one end of the pool to the other.
3. **Empty Debris:** Once the net contains a significant amount of debris, lift it out of the water. The fine mesh is designed to trap small particles while allowing water to pass through.
4. **Dispose:** Invert the net over a waste bin or designated area to empty the collected debris.
5. **Repeat:** Continue skimming until the water surface is clear of unwanted particles.

4. MAINTENANCE

- **Rinse After Use:** After each use, thoroughly rinse the net with fresh water to remove any chemical residues, dirt, or small particles trapped in the mesh.
- **Inspect Mesh:** Periodically inspect the fine mesh for tears, holes, or excessive wear. A damaged mesh may reduce skimming efficiency.
- **Check Handle Connection:** If using with a telescopic pole, ensure the connection point remains secure and free from cracks.
- **Storage:** Store the skimmer net in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and harsh chemicals when not in use. This helps prevent material degradation.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals on the net or handle, as this can damage the materials.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Net not collecting debris effectively.	Mesh is torn or clogged.	Rinse the net thoroughly. Inspect for damage; replace if necessary.
Handle feels loose when attached to a pole.	Pole not fully inserted or incompatible pole.	Ensure the pole is fully inserted and secured. Verify pole compatibility.
Net material appears brittle or discolored.	Prolonged exposure to sunlight or harsh chemicals.	Store the net in a cool, dry, shaded area when not in use. Avoid contact with strong chemicals.
