COMPONENTS OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your OLEVS watch:

- **Dial:** The watch face displaying time and sub-dials.
- **Hands:** Hour, minute, and second hands, plus sub-dial hands.
- **Crown:** Used for setting time and date (if applicable).
- **Pushers:** Buttons located on the side of the case, typically used for chronograph functions.
- **Stainless Steel Strap:** The metal band that secures the watch to your wrist.
- **Push Button Hidden Clasp:** Secure closure mechanism for the strap.
- **High Hardness Coated Glass Mirror:** The protective crystal over the dial, designed to be scratch-resistant.

SETUP

Setting the Time

1. Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to the first or second position (depending on the model, some watches have a date setting position).
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position to start the watch movement.

Adjusting the Stainless Steel Band

Your OLEVS watch comes with a steel band adjustment tool. If the band does not fit properly, you can use this tool to remove or add links for a comfortable fit. It is recommended to have a professional jeweler adjust the band if you are unsure.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Chronograph Function

The chronograph allows you to measure elapsed time. Your watch features sub-dials for minutes and a 24-hour indicator.

1. **Start:** Press the top pusher (button) to start the chronograph. The chronograph second hand will begin to move.
2. **Stop/Pause:** Press the top pusher again to stop or pause the chronograph.
3. **Reset:** With the chronograph stopped, press the bottom pusher to reset all chronograph hands to their zero positions.

Luminous Function

The hands of your OLEVS watch are designed with a luminous coating. To activate the luminescent function, expose the watch dial to strong light for at least 30 seconds. This will allow you to read the time in dark environments.

MAINTENANCE

Water Resistance (30M / 3ATM)

Your OLEVS watch is water resistant up to 30 meters. This means it is suitable for daily use and can withstand splashes, rain, or brief immersion in water. However, it is **not** suitable for showering, bathing, swimming, diving, or any water sports where it might be submerged for extended periods or exposed to high-pressure water. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, wipe it regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For the stainless steel band, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using chemical cleaners or abrasive materials.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement with a battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to skip, it indicates that the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:**

Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement. Consult a professional watch repair service.

- **Chronograph Hands Not Resetting to Zero:**

This can sometimes be corrected by pulling the crown out to the time-setting position and then pressing the pushers to align the hands. If this does not work, professional adjustment may be required.

- **Condensation Under the Crystal:**

If you notice condensation, it indicates moisture has entered the watch. This requires immediate attention from a professional watch repair service to prevent damage to the movement.
