INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your SANOTO Y30 Open Ear Headphones. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and longevity.

The SANOTO Y30 headphones feature an open-ear design for comfort and situational awareness, 14.2mm speakers for immersive stereo sound, dual-microphone noise reduction for clear calls, up to 30 hours of playtime with the charging case, and an IPX6 waterproof rating, making them suitable for various activities including sports.

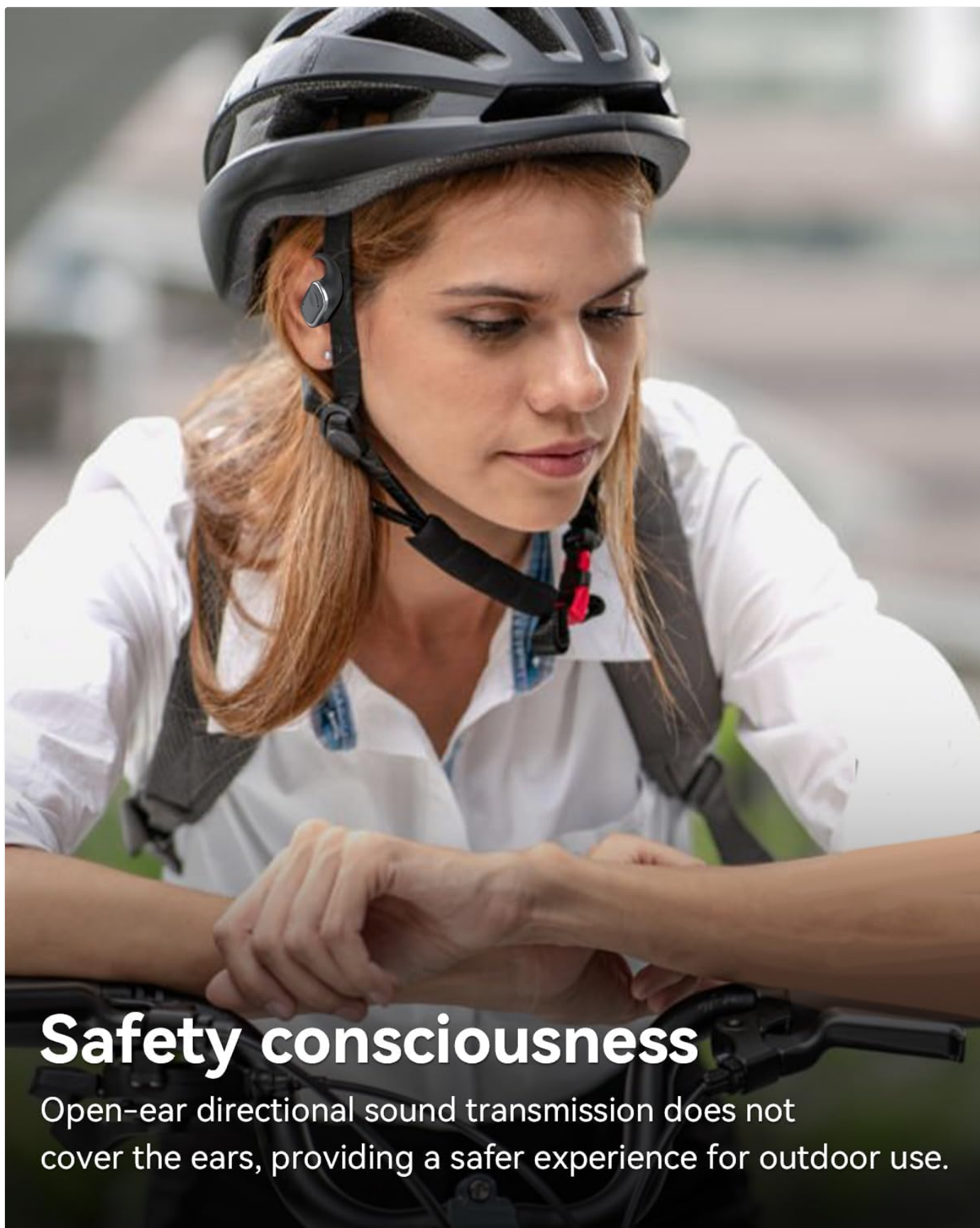

SETUP



1. Charging the Earbuds and Case




Before first use, fully charge the earbuds and the charging case.



1. Place the earbuds into the charging case. Ensure they are correctly seated.
2. Connect the USB Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the case and to a power source (e.g., USB wall adapter, computer USB port).
3. The indicator lights on the charging case will show the charging status. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours.
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charging cable.



Easy Control



-  Power on: X3 (either side)
-  Shutdown: X5 (either side)

-  Play/pause: X1 (either side)
-  Previous song: X2 (left ear)
-  Next song: X2 (right ear)

-  Volume +: X3 (left ear)
-  Volume -: X3 (right ear)

-  Answer/hang up: X1 (either side)
-  Reject calls: X2 (either side)

-  Voice assistant: X2 (either side)



2. Pairing with a Device

The earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode when taken out of the charging case.

1. Open the charging case and remove both earbuds. They will automatically power on and enter pairing mode.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth.
3. Search for available Bluetooth devices and select "SANOTO Y30" from the list.
4. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation prompt, and the indicator lights on the earbuds will change.
5. If pairing fails, place the earbuds back into the case, close it, and repeat the steps.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The SANOTO Y30 headphones feature intuitive touch controls on each earbud.

Touch Control Functions

Function	Action	Earbud
Power On	Tap 3 times	Either side

Function	Action	Earbud
Power Off	Tap 5 times	Either side
Play/Pause Music	Tap 1 time	Either side
Previous Song	Tap 2 times	Left ear
Next Song	Tap 2 times	Right ear
Volume Up	Tap 3 times	Left ear
Volume Down	Tap 3 times	Right ear
Answer/Hang Up Call	Tap 1 time	Either side
Reject Call	Tap 2 times	Either side
Activate Voice Assistant	Tap 2 times	Either side

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

- Gently wipe the earbuds and charging case with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- Ensure charging contacts are clean and dry.

2. Storage

- When not in use, store the earbuds in their charging case to protect them and keep them charged.
- Store in a cool, dry place, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

3. Water Resistance (IPX6)

The SANOTO Y30 earbuds are rated IPX6 waterproof, meaning they are resistant to high-pressure water jets from any direction. This makes them suitable for workouts and outdoor activities where they might be exposed to sweat or rain. However, they are not designed for submersion in water (e.g., swimming).

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Earbuds do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the earbuds and charging case fully.
Cannot pair with device.	Bluetooth is off; earbuds not in pairing mode; device too far.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Place earbuds back in case, then remove to re-enter pairing mode. Keep device within 10 meters.
No sound from earbuds.	Volume too low; not connected; media paused.	Increase volume on both earbuds and device. Check Bluetooth connection. Ensure media is playing.
Poor call quality.	Weak signal; environmental noise.	Move closer to your device. Try to reduce background noise.
Only one earbud works.	Earbuds not properly synced.	Place both earbuds back into the charging case, close the lid, then open and remove them together to re-sync.
