


Image: An exploded diagram illustrating the internal components of a Loop earplug, including the ear tip, mesh filter, membrane, and acoustic channel.



TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Loop Experience 2 Earplugs, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor noise reduction or sound quality.	Incorrect ear tip size or improper insertion.	Ensure you have selected the correct ear tip size for a snug fit. Re-insert the earplugs, twisting gently to create a seal. The earplugs should not protrude.
Discomfort or pain.	Ear tip size is too large or earplugs are inserted too deeply.	Try a smaller ear tip size. Ensure the earplug is not pushed too far into the ear canal.
Earplugs fall out easily.	Ear tip size is too small or earplugs are not inserted securely.	Try a larger ear tip size. Ensure the earplug is twisted gently to create a secure fit.
Earplugs feel dirty or clogged.	Accumulation of earwax or debris.	Clean the earplugs and ear tips thoroughly with a damp cloth and warm water. Ensure the acoustic channel is clear.


