1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your COLORROOM C5 Android 14 Tablet. Please read this manual carefully before using your device to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the tablet using the provided charger. Connect the Type-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the adapter to a power outlet. The charging indicator will show the charging status.

3.2 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button located on the side of the tablet until the COLORROOM logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a power-off menu appears. Select "Power off" and confirm.
- **To Restart:** From the power-off menu, select "Restart" and confirm.

3.3 Connecting Peripherals (Keyboard, Mouse, Stylus)

The included keyboard and mouse connect wirelessly via Bluetooth. The stylus is a passive touch pen and does not require pairing.

1. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your tablet (Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth).
2. Put the keyboard/mouse into pairing mode (refer to their individual instructions if needed).
3. On the tablet, search for available devices and select the keyboard/mouse to pair.

3.4 Wi-Fi and Bluetooth Connection

To connect to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Internet**.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi. The tablet will scan for available networks.
3. Select your desired network and enter the password if prompted.

To connect to a Bluetooth device:

1. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Connection preferences > Bluetooth**.
2. Turn on Bluetooth.
3. Ensure the Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
4. Select the device from the list of available devices to pair.

3.5 Inserting MicroSD Card

The tablet supports microSD cards up to 1TB for expanded storage.

1. Locate the microSD card slot on the side of the tablet.
2. Gently insert the microSD card into the slot until it clicks into place.
3. The tablet will recognize the new storage. You may be prompted to format it for optimal use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Navigation (Android 14)

Your tablet runs on Android 14, offering an intuitive user interface.

- **Home Screen:** Swipe left/right to navigate between home screens.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to access all installed applications.
- **Notifications & Quick Settings:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to view notifications and access quick settings toggles (Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, Brightness, etc.).
- **Multitasking:** Swipe up from the bottom and hold, then release to view recent apps. Swipe left/right to switch or swipe up to close an app.

More program operations

The C5 offers 6GB RAM and up to 12GB RAM with up to 6GB virtual memory expansion, combined with a 128GB high-speed storage cache and a micro SD card with 1TB capacity expansion to meet growing storage demands.

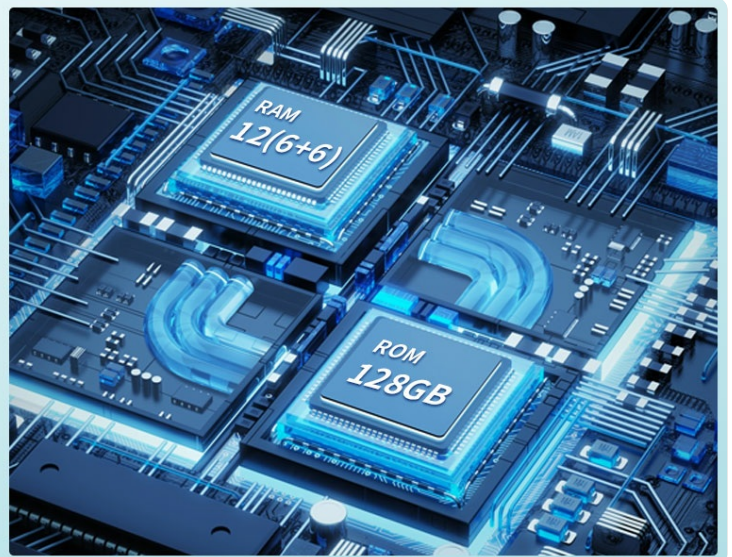


Image: The Android 14 operating system provides a new user experience with enhanced features.

4.2 Display Features

The 11-inch Full HD (800x1280) display with IPS Incell technology provides clear and vibrant visuals.

- **Brightness Adjustment:** Adjust screen brightness from the quick settings panel or in Settings > Display.
- **Screen Rotation:** Enable or disable auto-rotate from quick settings.

4.3 Performance and Storage

The tablet is powered by a Unisoc T606 octa-core processor and features 12GB RAM (6GB physical + 6GB extended) and 128GB internal storage.

4.4 Camera Usage

The tablet is equipped with dual cameras (front and rear).

- Open the **Camera** app from the home screen or app drawer.
- Tap the shutter button to take photos.
- Switch between front and rear cameras using the camera icon.

4.5 Wireless Projection

You can project your tablet's screen to a compatible external display wirelessly.

1. Ensure your external display supports wireless projection (e.g., Miracast, Chromecast).
2. On your tablet, go to **Settings > Connected devices > Connection preferences > Cast**.
3. Select your external display from the list to begin mirroring.

4.6 Google Play Store and Apps

The tablet is GMS certified, providing full access to the Google Play Store.

- Open the **Play Store** app.
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
- Browse and download applications, games, movies, and books.

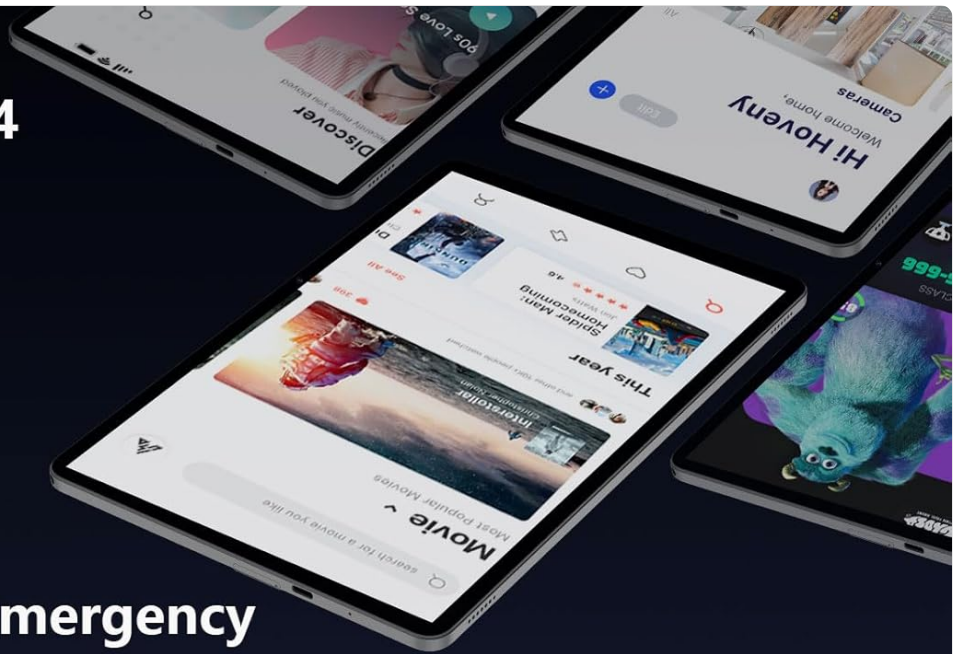

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Device

To clean your tablet, use a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

- Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to download and install any available updates.

5.3 Storage Management

To manage your tablet's storage:

- Go to **Settings > Storage**.
- Here you can see storage usage and free up space by uninstalling apps, deleting files, or clearing cache.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

Problem	Possible Solution
Tablet does not power on.	Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again. If unresponsive, try holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router and the tablet. Forget the network and reconnect. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.
Slow performance.	Close unused apps. Clear app caches (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Free up storage space. Restart the tablet.
Apps crashing or freezing.	Force stop the app (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Force stop). Clear the app's cache and data. Reinstall the app. Ensure the tablet's software is up to date.
Bluetooth device not pairing.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both devices. Put the Bluetooth device in pairing mode. Make sure the devices are close to each other. Restart both devices.
Camera not working.	Check app permissions for the camera (Settings > Apps > Camera > Permissions). Restart the tablet. If the issue persists, a factory reset might be necessary (see below).

6.1 Factory Reset

If you experience persistent issues, a factory reset can resolve many software-related problems. **Warning: This will erase all data on your tablet. Back up important data before proceeding.**

1. Go to **Settings > System > Reset options**.
2. Select **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/password if prompted.


