1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ApoloSign EP103A is a 10.1-inch Android 13 tablet designed for versatile use, from entertainment to productivity. It features an Octa-core processor, 8GB RAM (4GB physical + 4GB virtual), and a 1920x1200 pixel display. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

2. GETTING STARTED: SETUP

2.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Verify that all components are present and undamaged. The package typically includes the ApoloSign EP103A tablet, a user guide, a power adapter, and a USB cable.

2.2 Initial Charge

Before first use, fully charge the tablet. Connect the provided USB cable to the tablet's Type-C port and the power adapter, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet. The charging indicator will typically illuminate. A full charge may take several hours.

2.3 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (located on the top edge, as shown in Image 2.2) until the ApoloSign logo appears on the screen.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a menu appears. Select 'Power off' from the options.
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power button until a menu appears. Select 'Restart' from the options.

2.4 Initial Setup Wizard

Upon first power-on, the tablet will guide you through an initial setup process. Follow the on-screen prompts to:

- **Select Language:** Choose your preferred language.
- **Connect to Wi-Fi:** Select your Wi-Fi network and enter the password.
- **Set Date and Time:** Configure these settings, usually automatically if connected to Wi-Fi.
- **Sign in to Google Account:** Enter your Google account credentials or create a new one. This is necessary to download apps from the Google Play Store.
- **Set Screen Lock:** Configure a PIN, pattern, or password for security.

3. OPERATING YOUR TABLET

3.1 Home Screen and Navigation

The home screen is your central hub for accessing apps and widgets. Swipe left or right to navigate between home screens. Use gestures like swiping down from the top for notifications and quick settings.

3.2 App Management

- **Installing Apps:** Open the 'Play Store' app, search for your desired application, and tap 'Install'.
- **Uninstalling Apps:** Press and hold an app icon on the home screen or app drawer, then drag it to 'Uninstall' or select 'App info' and choose 'Uninstall'.
- **Managing Storage:** The tablet comes with 64GB of internal storage, expandable up to 128GB using a TF (microSD) card. Insert the TF card into the designated slot (refer to Image 2.2).

3.3 Camera Usage

The tablet is equipped with a 5MP rear camera and a 2MP front camera. Open the 'Camera' app to capture photos and videos.

- Tap the shutter button to take a photo.
- Switch between photo and video modes.
- Use the front camera for video calls and selfies.

3.4 Connectivity

- **Wi-Fi 6:** Connect to high-speed Wi-Fi networks for internet access. Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi.
- **Bluetooth 5.0:** Pair with Bluetooth devices such as headphones, speakers, or keyboards. Go to Settings > Connected devices > Pair new device.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.2 Cleaning

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.

4.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your ApolloSign EP103A tablet.

5.1 Common Issues and Solutions

- **Tablet not powering on:** Ensure the tablet is charged. Connect it to the charger for at least 30 minutes before attempting to power on again.
- **Tablet not charging:** Verify the charging cable and adapter are securely connected and undamaged. Try a different outlet or a compatible charger.
- **Slow performance or apps closing randomly:** Close unnecessary background applications. Clear app caches (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Consider uninstalling rarely used apps or moving large files to an external TF card.
- **Low speaker volume:** Check the volume settings (use the Volume+ button or adjust in Settings > Sound). Ensure no external audio devices are connected via Bluetooth or the headphone jack.
- **Wi-Fi connectivity issues:** Restart your tablet and your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network in tablet settings and reconnect.

5.2 Factory Reset

If your tablet experiences persistent software issues, a factory reset may resolve them.**Warning:** A factory reset will erase all data on your tablet. Back up important data before proceeding.

1. Go to **Settings**.
2. Navigate to **System**.
3. Select **Reset options**.
4. Choose **Erase all data (factory reset)**.
5. Confirm your decision and follow the on-screen instructions.


