1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your WELOV P200 Pro Smart Air Purifier. Please read it thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **General Safety:** Always unplug the air purifier before cleaning, performing maintenance, or when not in use. Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- **Placement:** Ensure the air purifier is placed on a stable, level surface. Keep a distance of at least 15 inches (38 cm) from walls or furniture to prevent obstruction of air inlets and outlets.
- **Filter Preparation:** Before initial use, remove all plastic packaging from the filter. Failure to do so will prevent proper air purification.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Do not use the air purifier in wet or damp environments, or near heat sources.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep the appliance out of reach of children and pets. Do not allow them to play with or on the air purifier.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The WELOV P200 Pro Smart Air Purifier is designed to improve indoor air quality. It features a sleek design with intuitive controls and smart connectivity.

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking and Filter Installation

1. Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.

2. Locate the filter compartment, usually at the bottom or back of the unit.
3. Remove the protective plastic bag from the filter.
4. Insert the filter back into the compartment, ensuring it is correctly seated.
5. Close the filter compartment cover securely.

4.2 Power Connection

Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet (AC120V, 60Hz). The unit will power on or enter standby mode.

4.3 App Pairing and Smart Home Integration

The WELOV P200 Pro supports Matter 1.2, allowing seamless integration with various smart home ecosystems like Apple HomeKit, Google Home, Alexa, and SmartThings. For advanced features, use the AiDot App.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel Functions

The top panel of your air purifier features various touch controls for direct operation:

- **Power Button:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through different operating modes (e.g., Auto, Manual, Sleep).
- **Fan Speed:** Adjusts the fan speed manually.
- **Timer:** Sets a countdown timer for operation.
- **Night Light:** Controls the ambient night light.
- **Display:** Toggles the display on/off.
- **Child Lock:** Prevents accidental changes to settings.

5.2 Smart Control via AiDot App

The AiDot app unlocks the full potential of your WELOV P200 Pro, offering advanced control and monitoring features.

5.2.1 Innovative Sleep Mode

The Sleep Mode can sync with Apple Health to adjust fan levels according to your sleep patterns. It operates as quietly as 23dB, creating a serene environment. The adjustable warm night light further enhances ambiance.

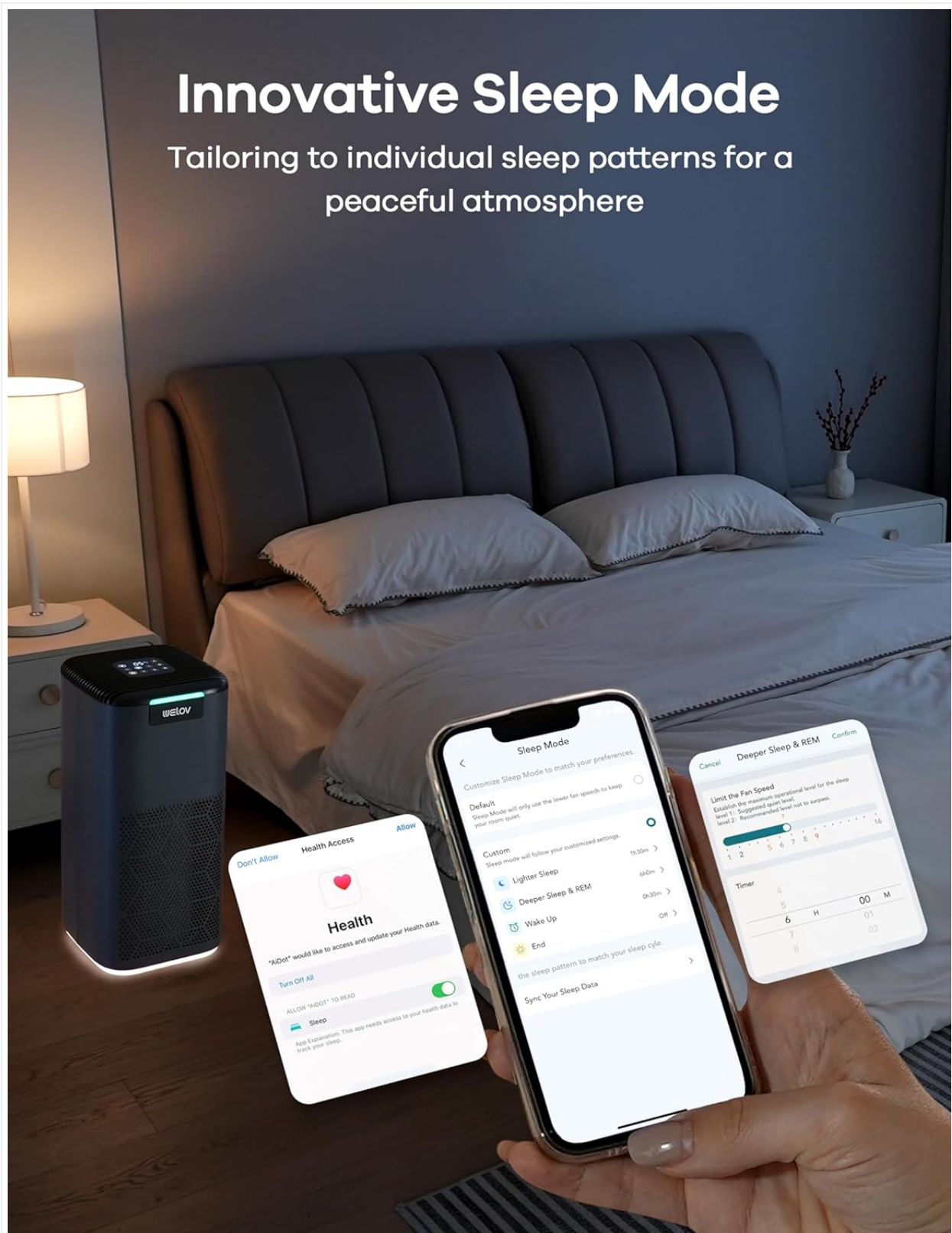


Figure 2: The air purifier in a bedroom setting, illustrating the innovative Sleep Mode that syncs with Apple Health for optimized fan levels and a soothing night light.

5.2.2 Precise Air Insight

Stay informed about real-time indoor air quality, including PM2.5 levels. The app also tracks external environmental factors such as ozone, wildfires, humidity, and pollen, providing a comprehensive overview of your air quality.

5.2.3 Automations and Scheduling

Set up custom automations to turn the air purifier on or off based on specific triggers (e.g., air quality levels) or schedule its operation for specific times of the day.

5.3 Voice Control

Utilize voice commands through compatible smart assistants like Amazon Alexa, Google Home, and Apple HomeKit (via Matter 1.2) to control your air purifier hands-free.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Filter Replacement

The WELOV P200 Pro uses a medical-grade HEPA filter designed to capture 99.997% of harmful ultra-fine particles. The replacement filter should be changed every 3-6 months, depending on local air quality and usage frequency. The AiDot app provides a filter life indicator to help you track its status.

6.2 Cleaning

Regularly wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure the air inlets and outlets are free from dust and debris.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Unit Not Turning On:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Ensure the filter is correctly installed and its compartment cover is closed.
- **Poor Air Purification:** Verify that the filter's plastic packaging has been removed. Check the filter life in the AiDot app; replace if necessary. Ensure the unit is not obstructed.
- **App Connectivity Issues:** Confirm your Wi-Fi network is 2.4 GHz. Restart your router and the air purifier. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device during pairing.
- **Unusual Noise:** Check for any foreign objects inside the unit or if the filter is improperly seated.


