



4. SETUP

4.1 SIM Card & MicroSD Installation

The Blackview Color 8 supports dual Nano SIM cards and one MicroSD/TF card for expanded storage. Use the provided SIM tray ejector tool to open the tray.

1. Locate the SIM tray slot on the side of your phone.
2. Insert the SIM tray ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano SIM cards and/or MicroSD card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring correct orientation.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone until it clicks into place.

4.2 Initial Power On & Charging

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your device.

1. Connect the provided power adapter to your phone's USB Type-C port.
2. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. The charging indicator will appear on the screen.
3. To power on, press and hold the Power button (located on the side) until the Blackview logo appears.
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection, Wi-Fi connection, and Google account setup.

5. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

5.1 Basic Navigation

The Blackview Color 8 operates on Android 13 with Doke OS 4.0, offering intuitive navigation through gestures or on-screen buttons.

- **Home Screen:** Swipe left or right to access different pages of apps and widgets.
- **App Drawer:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to view all installed applications.
- **Notifications & Quick Settings:** Swipe down from the top of the screen to access notifications and quick settings toggles.

5.2 Display Features

The device features a large 6.75-inch HD+ display with a 90Hz refresh rate for a smooth visual experience.

- **Screen Size:** 6.75 inches
- **Refresh Rate:** 90Hz for fluid scrolling and animations.

- **Brightness:** Up to 450 nits for clear visibility in various lighting conditions.
- **Colors:** Supports 16.7 million colors for vibrant visuals.





6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Battery Management

The 6000mAh battery provides extended usage. To optimize battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Use the provided 18W fast charger for efficient charging.
- Enable battery saver modes when needed.
- Close unused background applications.

6.2 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to new features. Updates are typically found in the device's Settings menu under 'System' or 'About phone'.

6.3 Cleaning and Care

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Keep the device away from excessive dust and moisture.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Blackview Color 8.

7.1 Device Not Powering On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the phone to the charger for at least 15 minutes.
- Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.

7.2 Poor Network Signal

- Check if your SIM card is correctly inserted.
- Move to an area with better network coverage.
- Restart the device.

- Verify that your carrier supports the phone's 4G bands (refer to specifications).

7.3 Apps Crashing or Freezing

- Clear the cache and data for the problematic app in Settings > Apps.
- Ensure the app is updated to its latest version.
- Free up storage space if your device is running low.

7.4 Fingerprint/Face ID Not Working

- Ensure your finger is clean and dry for fingerprint recognition.
- Ensure your face is well-lit and unobstructed for Face ID.
- Re-register your fingerprint or face in the Security settings.
