## 1. INTRODUCTION

- Do not operate the cleaner if the power adapter or charging port is damaged.
- Ensure the cleaner is fully submerged in water before activation.
- Keep children and pets away from the pool area while the cleaner is in operation.
- Only use the original power adapter provided for charging.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the cleaner yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Remove the cleaner from the pool before adding chemicals or performing maintenance on the pool itself.




Image: An X-ray view of the Grennx Robot Pool Cleaner showing its internal components, including the filter, dual motors, charging port, and 18650 battery cells.










## 5. SETUP

Follow these steps for initial setup:

- Charge the Cleaner:** Before first use, fully charge the cleaner using the provided power adapter. Connect the adapter to the charging port on the cleaner and plug it into a standard electrical outlet. The charging indicator will show the charging status.
- Prepare the Pool:** Ensure the pool is free of large debris that could obstruct the cleaner's movement or suction.
- Submerge the Cleaner:** Gently place the Grennix Robot Pool Cleaner into the pool. Ensure it is fully submerged and air bubbles have escaped before activation.

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your Grennix Robot Pool Cleaner is straightforward:

- Activate:** Once fully submerged, turn on the cleaner using the ON/OFF switch. The cleaner will begin its cleaning cycle automatically.
- Cleaning Cycle:** The cleaner will navigate the pool floor, collecting debris. Its self-docking feature allows it to return to the pool edge when the battery is low.
- Retrieval:** Once the cleaning cycle is complete or the cleaner has docked, use the provided retrieval hook to safely pull the cleaner out of the water.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your cleaner:

- Clean the Filter:** After each use, remove and clean the filter. Rinse it thoroughly with water to remove collected debris. Ensure the filter is completely dry before reinserting.
- Charge the Battery:** Keep the battery charged. Do not leave the battery completely discharged for extended periods.
- Handle with Care:** Always handle the cordless design properly, avoiding drops or impacts.
- Storage:** When not in use, store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is clean and fully charged before storing for long periods.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Grennix Robot Pool Cleaner, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner does not turn on.	Low battery; ON/OFF switch not engaged.	Charge the cleaner fully; ensure the switch is in the 'ON' position.
Cleaner moves slowly or stops.	Low battery; filter clogged; debris stuck in motors.	Recharge the cleaner; clean the filter; check for and remove any obstructions.
Poor suction performance.	Filter is dirty or clogged.	Remove and thoroughly clean the filter.
Cleaner does not dock automatically.	Obstruction near docking area; sensor issue.	Clear any debris around the pool edge; if problem persists, contact support.
