SAFETY INFORMATION

For safe assembly, installation, and use of this product, please observe the following guidelines:

- **Two-Person Assembly:** It is recommended to have multiple people handle the 123.9-pound product during assembly and installation. This will help prevent injury and ensure proper alignment of components.
- **Handle with Caution:** Carefully handle all metal components to prevent cuts or pinches during assembly and disassembly. Some edges may be sharp.
- **Follow Instructions:** Always follow the provided assembly instructions step-by-step. Do not deviate from the instructions.
- **Secure Installation:** Ensure the gazebo is securely anchored to the ground or deck surface to prevent tipping or movement due to wind.
- **Proper Placement:** Position the gazebo on a level surface. Do not place the gazebo near open flames or heat sources other than the intended grill area.

- **Ventilation:** The double-layered roof design is for air circulation. Ensure adequate ventilation when grilling to allow smoke and heat to escape.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts listed in the packaging are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer service immediately.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires careful attention to detail and may be easier with two people. Tools required are typically included or standard household tools.

Step 1: Assemble the Frame

Begin by assembling the main support frame. The frame is constructed from sturdy, powder-coated steel for durability and rust resistance. Ensure all connections are secure.

Step 2: Install the Roof Panels

Attach the double galvanized steel roof panels. The two-tier ventilated roof design promotes excellent air circulation, allowing smoke and heat to escape efficiently while grilling. It also offers protection from sun (UV resistant) and light rain.

Step 3: Attach Side Shelves and Accessories

Secure the two convenient side shelves to the frame. These shelves provide ample space for food preparation, condiments, and grilling tools. Install the versatile ceiling hook and the built-in bottle opener.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the steel frame and roof panels with a mild soap solution and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry to prevent water spots. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scrubbers that could damage the finish.
- **Rust Prevention:** The frame is rust-resistant, but regular inspection for scratches or chips in the powder coating is recommended. Touch up any damaged areas to prevent rust.
- **Seasonal Storage:** While designed for outdoor use, consider disassembling and storing the gazebo in a dry, sheltered area during extreme weather conditions or prolonged periods of non-use to extend its lifespan.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Domi Hardtop Grill Gazebo, consider the following common solutions:

- **Stability Issues:** Ensure the gazebo is placed on a level surface. Verify that all frame connections are securely tightened and that the base is properly anchored to the ground.
- **Roof Panel Alignment:** If roof panels do not align correctly during assembly, re-check the frame squareness

and ensure panels are installed in the correct sequence as per the detailed instructions in the physical manual.

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** If any parts are missing or damaged upon arrival, contact Domi customer service immediately for replacements.
