- 1 x Akozon Aluminum Alloy Bike Brake Caliper (Blue)
- Necessary mounting hardware (bolts, washers, nuts)

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section outlines the general steps for installing the Akozon Bike Brake Caliper. Specific installation procedures may

vary depending on your bicycle frame and fork design. Professional installation is recommended if you are unfamiliar with bicycle brake systems.

1. **Prepare the Mounting Area:** Ensure the brake mounting points on your bicycle frame (for rear brake) or fork (for front brake) are clean and free of debris.
2. **Attach the Caliper:** Position the brake caliper onto the designated mounting bolt. Secure it loosely with the provided nut and washer.
3. **Install Brake Pads:** Ensure the brake pads are correctly oriented and securely attached to the caliper arms. The pads should align with the rim's braking surface.
4. **Connect Brake Cable:** Route the brake cable through the caliper's cable guide and secure it with the cable anchor bolt. Ensure there is appropriate tension in the cable.
5. **Center the Caliper:** Squeeze the brake lever several times to seat the pads. Adjust the caliper's position so that both brake pads are equidistant from the rim and engage simultaneously when the lever is pulled. Tighten the main mounting bolt securely.
6. **Adjust Brake Pad Clearance:** Ensure there is a small, even gap between the brake pads and the rim when the brake lever is released. Adjust cable tension as needed.
7. **Final Check:** Verify all bolts are tightened to the manufacturer's specifications (if available for your bike). Test the brake lever for firm and responsive action.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To operate the Akozon Bike Brake Caliper, simply squeeze the corresponding brake lever on your handlebars. The brake caliper will engage the brake pads against the wheel rim, slowing or stopping the bicycle.

- **Front Brake (Left Lever):** Provides strong stopping power. Use with caution, especially at high speeds, to avoid locking the front wheel.

- **Rear Brake (Right Lever):** Offers more controlled deceleration and stability.
- **Combined Braking:** For optimal stopping power and control, apply both front and rear brakes simultaneously, with slightly more pressure on the rear brake initially.
- **Modulation:** Practice modulating brake pressure to achieve smooth and controlled stops without skidding.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your brake caliper.

- **Cleanliness:** Keep the brake caliper, pads, and wheel rims clean. Dirt and grime can reduce braking effectiveness and accelerate wear.
- **Brake Pad Inspection:** Regularly check brake pads for wear indicators. Replace pads when they are worn down to the minimum thickness line or if they become hardened or contaminated.
- **Cable Inspection:** Inspect brake cables and housing for fraying, kinks, or corrosion. Replace damaged cables promptly.
- **Pivot Points:** Apply a small amount of light lubricant to the caliper's pivot points periodically to ensure smooth operation.
- **Bolt Tightness:** Periodically check all mounting bolts and cable anchor bolts to ensure they are securely tightened.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Weak braking power	Worn brake pads, loose cable, contaminated pads/rims	Replace pads, tighten cable, clean pads/rims with appropriate cleaner
Squealing noise during braking	Contaminated pads/rims, misaligned pads, loose caliper	Clean pads/rims, adjust pad angle, tighten caliper mounting bolt
Brake lever feels spongy	Stretched cable, worn cable housing	Adjust cable tension, replace cable and housing if necessary
Brake pads rub on rim constantly	Caliper off-center, cable too tight, bent rim	Center caliper, loosen cable, true wheel rim
