INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your VTech CL6550 Corded and DECT Cordless Phone system. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The VTech CL6550 is a versatile communication system combining a corded desk phone with a DECT cordless handset. It is designed for ease of use with features catering to various user needs.

Key Features:

- Call Blocking for Nuisance and Unknown Calls: Block up to 100 unwanted numbers to ensure uninterrupted communication.
- Integrated Digital Answering Machine: Features slow playback and up to 30 minutes of recording time.
- Handset and Base Speakerphone: Enables hands-free conversations from both the corded base and the cordless handset.
- Large Buttons and Large Display: Designed for clear visibility and ease of use, especially for users who prefer a tactile interface.
- Photo Dial Keys for Quick Dialing: Program up to eight frequently dialed numbers with associated photos for easy identification and quick access.
- Talking Numbers: Announces dialed digits for confirmation.
- Visual Ring Indicator: A light indicator on the base signals incoming calls.
- Volume Booster: Enhances audio for clearer conversations.
- Equalizer: Adjust audio quality for personalized listening.
- Hearing Aid Compatible: Designed to work effectively with hearing aids.

Components:

Corded Base Unit

- Corded Handset
- Cordless Handset
- Cordless Handset Charger
- Telephone Line Cord
- AC Power Adapter (for base)
- Rechargeable NiMH Batteries (for cordless handset)

SETUP

1. Connect the Corded Base Unit:

- Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the TEL LINE jack on the back of the corded base.
- Plug the other end of the telephone line cord into a telephone wall jack.
- Connect the AC power adapter to the POWER jack on the back of the corded base.
- Plug the AC power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

2. Install Cordless Handset Batteries:

- Open the battery compartment cover on the back of the cordless handset.
- Insert the supplied NiMH batteries, observing the polarity markings (+ and -).
- Close the battery compartment cover.

3. Charge the Cordless Handset:

- Place the cordless handset in its charging cradle.
- Ensure the "Charging" indicator on the handset or cradle illuminates.
- Allow the handset to charge for at least 16 hours before initial use.

4. Set Date and Time:

 Follow the on-screen prompts on the cordless handset or refer to the menu options on the corded base to set the current date and time. This is important for accurate call logs and answering machine timestamps.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

• To Make a Call:

- $\,\circ\,$ Pick up the corded handset or press TALK on the cordless handset.
- o Dial the phone number. The numbers will be announced if the talking numbers feature is enabled.
- Alternatively, use a Photo Dial Key or a speed dial entry.

• To Answer a Call:

- Pick up the corded handset or press **TALK** on the cordless handset.
- $\,\circ\,$ The visual ring indicator on the base will flash during an incoming call.

• Using Speakerphone:

- During a call, press the SPEAKER button on the corded base or the cordless handset to activate the speakerphone.
- Press it again to switch back to the handset.

Call Blocking:

• To Block a Number:

- During an incoming call, press the **CALL BLOCK** button on the corded base or cordless handset.
- Alternatively, access the call block menu through the phone's settings and manually add numbers to the blacklist (up to 100 entries).

Answering Machine:

- Playing Messages: Press the PLAY/STOP button on the corded base.
- Slow Playback: During message playback, press the SLOW button to activate slow playback for better comprehension.

Photo Dial Keys:

• Programming:

- $\circ~$ Lift the corded handset or press TALK on the cordless handset.
- Press the **STORE** button.
- o Dial the phone number you wish to save.
- Press the desired Photo Dial Key (1-8).
- You can insert a small photo under the clear cover of each key for visual identification.

• Making a Call with Photo Dial: Simply press the desired Photo Dial Key (1-8) to automatically dial the stored number.

Volume and Audio Settings:

- Volume Booster: Press the VOL+ button on the side of the corded base or the cordless handset during a call to increase the listening volume.
- Equalizer: Access the menu on the cordless handset or corded base to adjust equalizer settings for preferred audio quality.



MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the phone surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Battery Care:** Replace the cordless handset batteries when they no longer hold a charge effectively. Use only approved NiMH replacement batteries.
- Storage: If storing the phone for an extended period, remove the batteries from the cordless handset.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
No dial tone.	 Ensure the telephone line cord is securely connected to both the phone base and the wall jack. Check if other phones on the same line are working.

Problem	Solution
Cordless handset not charging.	 Verify the cordless handset is correctly seated in the charging cradle. Ensure the charging cradle's power adapter is plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check the battery connections inside the handset.
Cannot hear caller / Caller cannot hear me.	 Adjust the volume using the VOL+ / VOL- buttons. Ensure the mute function is not activated. Check the line cord connection.
Answering machine not recording.	 Ensure the answering machine is turned ON. Check if the memory is full. Delete old messages if necessary.
