# Montezuma DeWalt 30" x 15" Triangle Toolbox User Manual (Model DXTB30BY)

Comprehensive instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance of your Montezuma DeWalt Triangle Toolbox.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your Montezuma DeWalt 30" x 15" Triangle Toolbox. Please read these instructions carefully before using the product and retain them for future reference.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Montezuma DeWalt Triangle Toolbox is a multi-tier storage solution designed for organizing and securing various tools and supplies. Its robust steel construction and weather-resistant features ensure durability and protection for your equipment.

### Key Features:

- **Multi-tier Design:** Accommodates larger tools and provides organized storage.
- **Socket Pegs:** Full height pegs offer flexible organization for sockets.
- **Tool Platforms:** Dedicated areas for storing ratchets, extensions, and screwdrivers.
- **Wrench Pegs:** 11 gauge steel pegs designed for spacing ratcheting wrenches.
- **Driver Slot:** Convenient storage for a power driver, with or without a battery.
- **Integrated Power Strip:** Steel lift-up socket tray includes a 3-outlet power strip with 2 USB ports for charging

tools and devices.

- **Weather Seal:** Protects contents from moisture and dust.
- **Locking Latch:** Secures the toolbox contents.

### 3. SETUP

The Montezuma DeWalt Triangle Toolbox is designed for immediate use with minimal setup. Ensure the toolbox is placed on a stable, level surface before loading tools.

#### Unpacking:

1. Carefully remove the toolbox from its packaging.
2. Inspect the toolbox for any signs of damage during transit. If damage is found, contact customer support immediately.
3. Remove any protective materials or internal packaging.

## Initial Inspection:

- Verify that the locking latch operates smoothly.
- Check the integrity of the weather seal around the lid.
- Ensure all internal components, such as socket pegs and tool platforms, are securely in place.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Opening and Closing the Toolbox:

1. To open, disengage the locking latch located on the front of the lid.
2. Lift the lid upwards. The lid is designed to stay open for easy access to tools.
3. To close, gently lower the lid until it rests securely on the base. Engage the locking latch to secure the toolbox.

### Organizing Tools:

- **Socket Storage:** Utilize the full-height socket pegs for various socket sizes.
- **Wrench Storage:** Place ratcheting wrenches on the 11 gauge steel wrench pegs.
- **Ratchets, Extensions, Screwdrivers:** Use the designated tool platforms for these items.
- **Driver Storage:** A dedicated slot is available for storing a power driver, with or without its battery attached.
- **Lower Compartment:** The main compartment beneath the lift-up tray provides space for larger tools or bulkier items.

## Using the Integrated Power Strip:

1. Locate the steel lift-up socket tray. The power strip is integrated into this tray.
2. Plug the toolbox's power cord into a standard electrical outlet.
3. Connect your tools or devices to the 3 AC outlets or 2 USB ports for charging.
4. Ensure the lid is open when using the power strip to prevent overheating and allow access.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your toolbox.

### Cleaning:

- Wipe down exterior and interior surfaces with a damp cloth.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.
- Ensure the toolbox is dry before closing to prevent moisture buildup.

### Weather Seal:

- Periodically inspect the weather seal around the lid for cracks or damage.
- A damaged seal may compromise the water and dust resistance of the toolbox.

### Locking Latch:

- Keep the locking mechanism clean and free of debris.
- Apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., silicone spray) if the latch becomes stiff.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lid does not close properly.	Tools obstructing the closing path; damaged hinges or seal.	Rearrange tools; inspect hinges and weather seal for damage.
Locking latch is stiff or difficult to operate.	Debris in mechanism; lack of lubrication.	Clean the latch mechanism; apply a small amount of lubricant.
Power strip is not providing power.	Not plugged into wall outlet; tripped circuit breaker; faulty power strip.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; check household circuit breaker; contact customer support if issue persists.
Moisture or dust inside the toolbox.	Damaged or improperly seated weather seal.	Inspect and replace weather seal if necessary. Ensure lid is fully closed and latched.




