BOVZA House Bunk Bed with Slide and Stairs Twin Over Twin - Instruction Manual

Model: House Bunk Bed with Slide and Stairs

1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before assembly and use of this product. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the weight capacity of 300 pounds (136 kg) for the upper bed and 300 pounds (136 kg) for the bottom bed. Exceeding these limits can compromise stability and safety.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with full-length guardrails. Ensure they are always securely in place to prevent falls.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Recommended mattress thickness for the upper bed is 4-6 inches (10-15 cm). For the bottom bed, the recommended thickness is 6-8 inches (15-20 cm). Using mattresses thicker than recommended may reduce the effectiveness of the guardrails.
- **Age Recommendation:** This bunk bed is recommended for users aged 6 years and older.
- **Assembly:** Assembly requires two adults. Ensure all hardware is tightened securely before use and periodically check for loose connections.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping on the bed or slide.
- **Slide Safety:** Use the slide feet first. Ensure the area around the slide exit is clear.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BOVZA House Bunk Bed is a twin-over-twin metal bunk bed frame designed with a house-shaped structure. It includes an integrated slide and a staircase with built-in storage compartments. The design incorporates a roof frame and a decorative window element on the upper bunk.

Note: The product is shipped in two separate packages, which may arrive at different times. Please ensure both packages have been received before beginning assembly.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the BOVZA House Bunk Bed is required. Follow the detailed step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included in your package. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly.

General Assembly Guidelines:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all components and hardware. Verify that all parts listed in the assembly guide are present.
2. **Prepare Workspace:** Clear a spacious area for assembly. Place a soft cloth or carpet on the floor to prevent scratching parts.
3. **Follow Instructions:** Adhere strictly to the numbered steps in the assembly manual. Do not skip steps.
4. **Tighten Hardware:** Ensure all bolts, screws, and connectors are tightened securely. Do not overtighten, as this may strip threads or damage components.
5. **Final Check:** After assembly, perform a thorough check to ensure all parts are correctly installed and secured.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and recreational use within its safety guidelines.

Using the Bunk Beds:

- **Accessing the Upper Bunk:** Use the integrated staircase to safely access the upper bunk. Always use both hands on the handrails.

- **Sleeping:** Ensure mattresses are properly placed within the bed frame.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk guardrails are fixed and provide continuous protection. Do not attempt to remove or modify them.

Using the Slide:

- **Supervision:** Children should be supervised when using the slide.
- **Position:** Always slide feet first.
- **Clear Area:** Ensure the area at the bottom of the slide is clear of obstructions and other individuals before sliding.
- **One Person at a Time:** Only one person should use the slide at a time.

Using the Storage Stairs:

- The staircase features three compartments beneath the steps. These can be used for storing toys, books, or other small items.
- Do not overload the storage compartments.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and safety of your bunk bed.

Cleaning:

- Wipe down metal and wooden surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes, as these can damage the finish.
- For spills, clean immediately to prevent staining.

Inspection:

- Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary.
- Check for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts on the frame, guardrails, slide, and stairs.
- If any damage is found, discontinue use until repairs are made or replacement parts are obtained.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

Squeaking Noises:

- **Cause:** Loose connections or friction between metal parts.
- **Solution:** Inspect all bolts and screws. Tighten any that are loose. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to the joints where metal parts meet.

Instability/Wobbling:

- **Cause:** Uneven floor or loose assembly.

- **Solution:** Ensure the bed is placed on a level surface. Recheck all assembly hardware and tighten any loose connections. If the floor is uneven, use shims under the bed legs to stabilize it.

Missing Parts During Assembly:

- **Cause:** Packaging error or parts in the second package.
- **Solution:** Verify that both packages have been received. Cross-reference the parts list in the assembly manual with the components you have. If parts are still missing, contact customer support.
