# 1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Bedsure Heated Flannel Blanket. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new heated blanket. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference.

The Bedsure Heated Flannel Blanket (Model: BS-EU130160) is designed to provide comfortable and adjustable warmth. It features multiple heating levels and a timer function for personalized comfort.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before using this heated blanket.
- Do not use this blanket with an infant, a child, an incapacitated person, or anyone insensitive to heat.
- Do not use this blanket in conjunction with another heating appliance.
- Ensure the blanket is not folded, bunched, or creased during use, as this can cause overheating.
- Do not insert pins or other metallic objects into the blanket.
- Keep the control unit away from water or other liquids.
- Always unplug the blanket from the power outlet when not in use or before cleaning.
- This blanket is equipped with a 9-hour automatic shut-off feature to prevent overheating and ensure safety.
- The blanket is CE, GS, UKCA, and RoHS certified, indicating compliance with relevant safety standards.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

# 4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your heated blanket:

- 1. Unpack the Blanket: Carefully remove the blanket and controller from its packaging.
- 2. Inspect for Damage: Check the blanket and controller for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
- 3. **Connect the Controller:** Locate the connector on the blanket and the corresponding plug on the controller. Ensure they are securely connected.
- 4. **Position the Blanket:** Lay the blanket flat on your bed, sofa, or desired surface. Ensure it is not folded, creased, or bunched up.
- 5. **Plug into Power:** Insert the power plug of the controller into a standard electrical outlet.

# 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The wired controller allows you to manage the blanket's heat and timer settings.

- Power On/Off: Press the 'ON/OFF' button to turn the blanket on or off. The display will illuminate when on.
- Adjust Temperature: Press the 'Temp' button to cycle through the 8 available heating levels. The current level will be displayed on the controller screen.
- **Set Timer:** Press the 'Time' button to select a desired operating time. The blanket offers 9 time settings. Once the set time expires, the blanket will automatically shut off.
- **Preheat Function:** The blanket can be preheated to achieve desired warmth before use. Simply turn it on and select your preferred heat level.
- Automatic Shut-off: For safety, the blanket will automatically turn off after 9 hours of continuous operation, even if a shorter timer was not set.

# 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper care will extend the life of your heated blanket.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the blanket from the power outlet and disconnect the controller from the blanket. Allow the blanket to cool completely.
- Washing: The blanket is washable. Refer to the care label attached to the blanket for specific washing instructions (e.g., machine wash cold on a gentle cycle, tumble dry low or air dry). Do not dry clean.
- **Drying:** Ensure the blanket is completely dry before reconnecting the controller and plugging it back into power.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the blanket in a cool, dry place. Avoid folding it tightly or placing heavy objects on it, which could damage the internal heating elements.

# 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your heated blanket, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

# • Blanket not heating:

- Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Verify that the controller is properly connected to the blanket.
- Check if the blanket is turned on and a heat level is selected.
- The automatic shut-off may have activated. Turn the blanket off and then on again.

#### Controller display not working:

- Ensure the power cord is plugged in and the blanket is turned on.
- Try unplugging and re-plugging the power cord.

## · Blanket feels too hot or not hot enough:

- Adjust the temperature setting using the 'Temp' button on the controller.
- Allow a few minutes for the blanket to reach the desired temperature.


