## 4. OPERATING AND USAGE

### 4.1 Age Suitability and Adjustments

The Tripp Trapp High Chair 2 with the Baby Set is designed for children aged 6-36 months. As your child grows, the Baby Set can be removed. The chair features adjustable seat and foot plates, allowing for ergonomic positioning from infancy through adulthood.

### 4.2 Ergonomic Design

The chair's design promotes proper posture with back and side support for babies learning to sit upright, and a 90-degree angle for optimal ergonomics. The adjustable footrest provides support for the child's feet, which is crucial for comfort and stability.

## 4.3 Safety Guidelines

- Always secure your child with the 5-point safety harness when the Baby Set is in use.
- Ensure the chair is placed on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- The included gliders should be attached for enhanced stability.
- Do not leave your child unattended in the high chair.
- The maximum weight recommendation for the chair is 300 lbs.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and hygiene of your Tripp Trapp High Chair 2.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down all wooden and plastic surfaces with a damp cloth. For more thorough cleaning, use a mild soap solution. Ensure all parts are dry before continued use.
- **Harness Care:** The five-point harness can be removed for cleaning. Refer to the care label on the harness for

specific washing instructions.

- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and fittings to ensure they are securely tightened.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common questions and minor issues you might encounter.

Issue	Possible Solution
Difficulty cleaning small crevices.	Use a small brush or a damp cloth wrapped around a thin object to reach tight spaces. Regular cleaning prevents buildup.
Child is difficult to place into the Baby Set.	Ensure the harness is fully loosened before attempting to place the child. Adjust the seat and foot plates to the correct height for easier access.
Chair feels unstable.	Verify that all screws are tightened. Ensure the extended gliders are properly installed on the base of the chair. Always use on a level surface.
