1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the JVC SPSG1BTB Portable Wireless Speakers. This product includes two distinct portable wireless speakers designed for enhanced audio experiences. One speaker offers 360° surround sound with Bluetooth 5.0 and an 1800mAh battery, providing up to 18 hours of playtime. The second speaker features a compact design with Bluetooth 5.3, offering up to 15 hours of battery life and integrated playback controls. Both speakers are IPX5 waterproof, making them suitable for various environments.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- 2 x JVC Portable Wireless Speakers (Model SPSG1BTB)
- 1 x Charging Cable (Micro USB, specific to the speaker model)
- 1 x User Manual (this document)

3. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the speakers to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for extended periods.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the speakers to strong impacts.
- Do not disassemble or attempt to repair the speakers yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.
- Keep the speakers away from medical devices.
- Ensure charging ports are dry before connecting the charging cable.
- Dispose of batteries according to local regulations.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Speakers

Before first use, fully charge both speakers. Connect the provided charging cable to the speaker's charging port and a USB power source (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter). The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging and turn off or change color when fully charged.

4.2 Powering On/Off

Press and hold the **Power button** (usually marked with a power symbol) for a few seconds to turn the speaker on or off. A sound or indicator light will confirm the status change.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on and in pairing mode. The Bluetooth indicator light will typically flash.

- 2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 3. Select "JVC SPSG1BTB" or a similar name from the list.
- 4. Once paired, the speaker will emit a confirmation sound, and the Bluetooth indicator light will become solid.

4.4 True Wireless Stereo (TWS) Pairing (for two speakers)

To use both speakers for a stereo experience:

- 1. Ensure both JVC SPSG1BTB speakers are charged and powered on.
- 2. Disconnect both speakers from any previously paired Bluetooth devices.
- 3. On one speaker (this will be the primary speaker), double-press the**Power button** or a dedicated TWS button (if available). The speaker will enter TWS pairing mode.
- 4. The two speakers will automatically connect to each other. A confirmation sound will indicate successful TWS pairing.
- 5. Once TWS paired, connect your device to the primary speaker via Bluetooth as described in section 4.3.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Basic Controls

Button/Control	Function
Power Button	Press and hold to Power On/Off. Short press for Play/Pause (when connected). Double press for TWS pairing (on one speaker).
Volume Up (+)	Short press to increase volume. Long press for next track.
Volume Down (-)	Short press to decrease volume. Long press for previous track.
Mode (M) Button	Short press to switch between input modes (if available, e.g., Bluetooth, AUX).

Note: Button functions may vary slightly between the two speaker models included in the bundle. Refer to the specific speaker's markings.

5.2 Making/Receiving Calls (if applicable)

If your speaker has a built-in microphone:

- **Answer Call:** Short press the **Power/Play/Pause button**.
- **End Call:** Short press the **Power/Play/Pause button** during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the **Power/Play/Pause button** for 2 seconds.

5.3 Waterproof Functionality (IPX5)

The speakers are rated IPX5, meaning they are protected against low-pressure water jets from any direction. This makes them suitable for use near pools or in light rain. They are not designed for submersion in water.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker's exterior. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the speakers in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the speakers frequently. Charge them regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- **Water Exposure:** After exposure to water, ensure the charging port is completely dry before charging to prevent damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Speaker does not turn on.	Ensure the speaker is charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing indicator).• Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.• Move the speaker closer to your device (within 33 feet/10 meters).• Forget the device from your phone's Bluetooth settings and try pairing again.• Restart both the speaker and your device.
No sound or low volume.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increase volume on both the speaker and your connected device.• Ensure the speaker is properly paired.• Check if the audio source is playing.
TWS pairing fails.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure both speakers are fully charged and disconnected from other Bluetooth devices.• Place speakers close to each other.• Follow TWS pairing steps precisely (Section 4.4).• Power cycle both speakers and try again.
Charging issue.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Verify the charging cable is securely connected to both the speaker and the power source.• Try a different USB port or wall adapter.• Ensure the charging port on the speaker is clean and dry.
