## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Mobile Wheels:** Equipped with mobile wheels for easy relocation and repositioning of the coop as needed.
- **Compact Mesh Mats:** Includes compact mesh mats designed to protect animal paws and provide a comfortable standing surface.
- **Secure Door Latch:** The cage is designed with a secure, anti-collision door latch to prevent escapes

and protect pets from predators.

### 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

This chicken coop is designed for immediate use with no assembly required. It arrives as a single, pre-assembled unit.

#### 3.1 Unpacking

1. Carefully remove the coop from its packaging.
2. Inspect the coop for any signs of damage during transit. If any damage is found, please contact customer support immediately.
3. Remove any protective materials or ties.

#### 3.2 Placement

The coop is suitable for both indoor and outdoor use. Consider the following when choosing a location:

- **Level Surface:** Ensure the coop is placed on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping and ensure proper

function of the wheels and tray.

- **Protection:** If placed outdoors, choose a location that offers some protection from extreme weather conditions (e.g., direct sun, heavy rain, strong winds).
- **Accessibility:** Position the coop in an area that allows easy access for feeding, cleaning, and interacting with your pets.

### 3.3 Initial Check

- Verify that all four wheels are securely attached and can rotate freely.
- Ensure the removable tray slides in and out smoothly and sits flush with the bottom of the cage.
- Check that the door opens and closes properly and the latch engages securely.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Using your chicken coop is straightforward. Follow these guidelines for daily operation:

### 4.1 Opening and Closing the Door

- To open the door, slide the secure latch mechanism and pull the door outwards.
- To close, push the door firmly until it aligns with the frame, then engage the latch to secure it. Always ensure the latch is fully engaged to prevent escapes.

### 4.2 Mobility

- The coop is equipped with wheels for easy movement. To move the coop, gently push or pull it to your desired location.
- For stability once positioned, ensure the wheels are locked if they have a locking mechanism, or place the coop against a wall or other stable object to prevent accidental movement.

### 4.3 Pet Placement

- Place appropriate bedding material (e.g., straw, wood shavings) on the mesh mats inside the coop.
- Provide fresh water and food in suitable containers within the coop.
- Introduce your pets to the coop gently. Monitor them closely during the initial period to ensure they adapt well to their new environment.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular cleaning and maintenance are crucial for the health and well-being of your pets and the longevity of the coop.

### 5.1 Cleaning the Removable Tray

1. Gently slide out the removable tray from the bottom of the coop.
2. Dispose of waste and bedding material responsibly.
3. Wash the tray with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reinserting it into the coop.

- Periodically wipe down the metal bars and surfaces of the coop with a damp cloth and mild, pet-safe disinfectant.
- Ensure all cleaning agents are thoroughly rinsed off and the coop is dry before returning pets.
- Replace bedding material regularly to maintain a fresh and hygienic environment.

## 5.3 Inspection and Maintenance

- Regularly check all welds, latches, and structural components for any signs of wear, damage, or loosening.
- Ensure the wheels are clean and free of debris to maintain smooth mobility.
- Address any issues promptly to prevent further damage or compromise to pet safety.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your chicken coop.

## 6.1 Difficulty Moving the Coop

- **Check Wheels:** Ensure no debris (e.g., straw, dirt) is obstructing the wheels. Clean them if necessary.
- **Surface:** Verify the coop is on a smooth, level surface. Movement on uneven ground or thick carpet may be challenging.

## 6.2 Door Not Latching Securely

- **Alignment:** Ensure the door is properly aligned with the frame before attempting to engage the latch.
- **Obstructions:** Check for any foreign objects or debris preventing the latch mechanism from fully engaging.
- **Damage:** Inspect the latch and door frame for any bending or damage that might impede its function.

## 6.3 Tray Difficult to Remove/Insert

- **Debris:** Clear any bedding or waste that may have fallen into the tray's runners.
- **Alignment:** Ensure the tray is inserted straight and level into its designated slots.
- **Damage:** Check the tray and its runners for any deformities or damage.
