SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to set up your Blackview Color 8 for the first time.

1. Inserting SIM and SD Cards

The Blackview Color 8 supports dual Nano SIM cards and one Micro SD/TF card for expanded storage. The device features a 3-card slot design.

1. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the phone.
2. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray.
3. Carefully place your Nano SIM cards and Micro SD card into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure the gold contacts are facing down.
4. Gently push the tray back into the phone until it is flush with the device body.

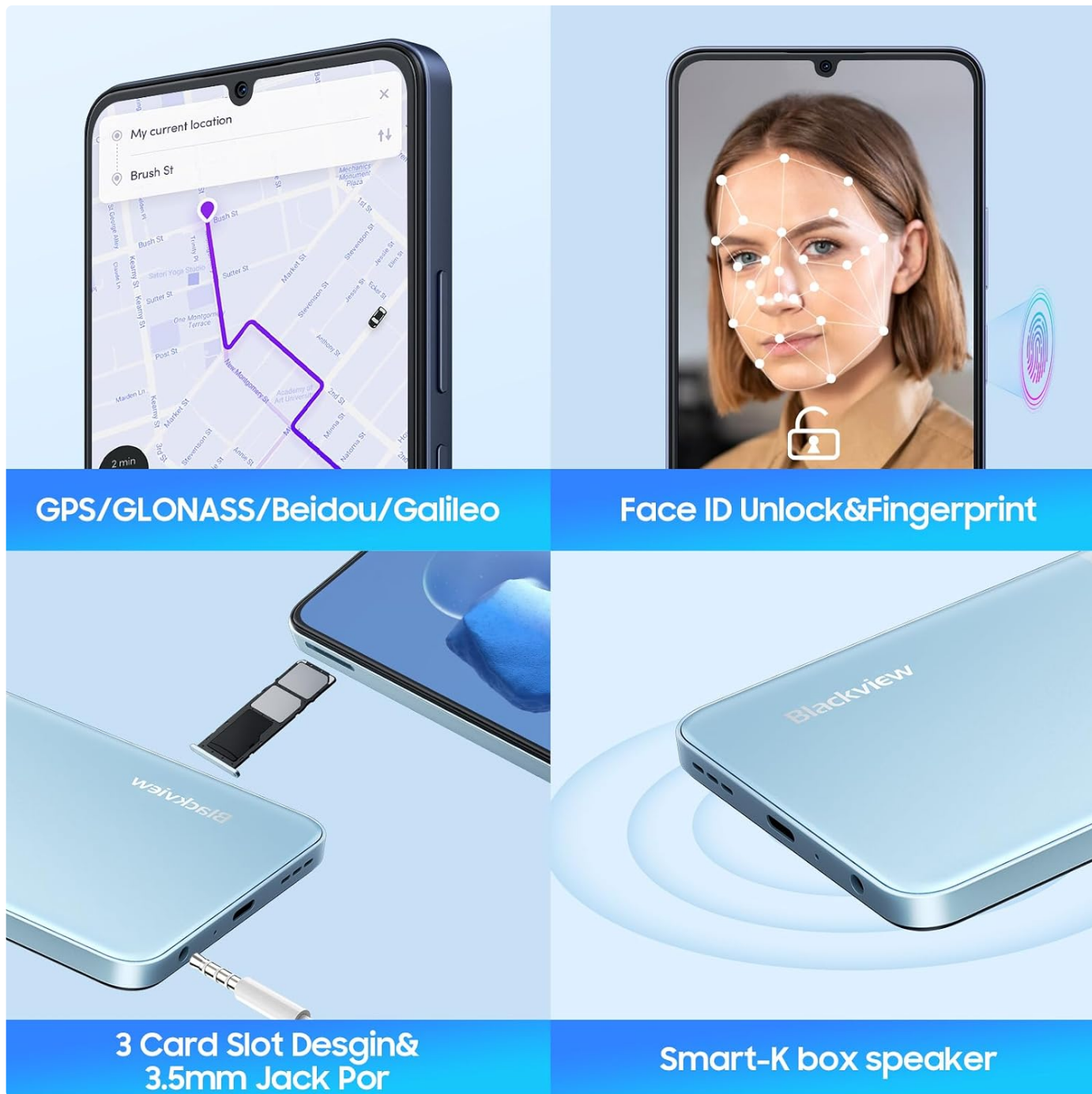

2. Initial Power On and Basic Configuration

1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the side, integrated with the fingerprint sensor) until the Blackview logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, region, and connect to a Wi-Fi network.
3. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one to access Google services and the Play Store.
4. Set up your preferred screen lock method, including fingerprint and Face ID for quick and secure access.

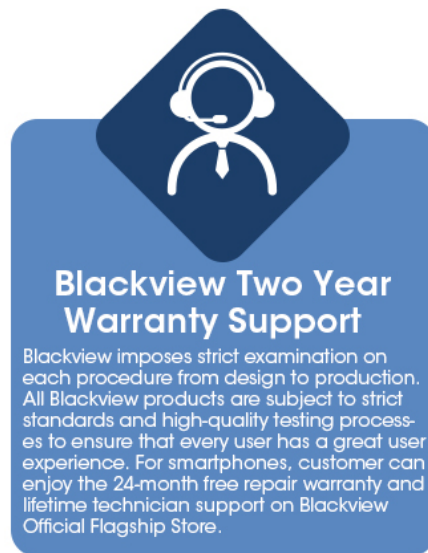


Image: A hand interacting with the side-mounted power button, which also functions as the fingerprint sensor, demonstrating instant access to the device.

Battery Management

- The OTG function allows the phone to act as a power bank for other devices. Connect a compatible OTG cable to charge other devices.

Connectivity and Navigation

The Color 8 supports 4G networks, 5G WiFi, and Bluetooth 5.0. For navigation, it utilizes GPS, Glonass, Galileo, and Beidou for precise positioning.

- Ensure your SIM card is active and compatible with supported carriers (T-Mobile, Speedtalk, Mint Mobile, etc.).
- Connect to Wi-Fi networks via Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi.
- Pair Bluetooth devices via Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth.
- Use mapping applications for navigation, leveraging the phone's 4-in-1 GPS system.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Blackview Color 8.

Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the screen and body.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or aerosol sprays.
- Keep ports free of dust and debris.

Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. You can usually find this option in Settings > System > System update.

Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, as they can degrade battery life.
- Do not leave the phone charging for excessively long periods after it reaches 100%.
- If storing the device for a long time, charge it to about 50% before turning it off.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Blackview Color 8.

Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on.
- Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to force a restart.

Poor Network Connectivity

- Check if your SIM card is properly inserted.

- Verify that your mobile data is enabled in Settings.
- Restart the phone.
- Ensure you are within your carrier's coverage area.
- Note: This phone is not compatible with CDMA carriers such as AT&T, Cricket Wireless, Verizon, Straight Talk, or U.S. Cellular.

Apps Crashing or Freezing

- Close and reopen the app.
- Clear the app's cache and data in Settings > Apps.
- Ensure the app is updated to its latest version from the Play Store.
- Restart your phone.

Battery Draining Quickly

- Reduce screen brightness.
- Disable unused features like Bluetooth, Wi-Fi, or GPS when not needed.
- Close background apps.
- Check battery usage in Settings to identify power-hungry applications.

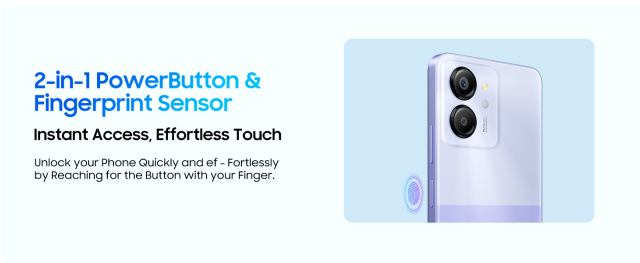
