1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Naturehike Cape 6 Person Camping Tent is designed for ease of use and durability, featuring a quick setup instant design with pre-attached poles. It offers ample space for up to 6 individuals, excellent ventilation, and robust weather protection for various outdoor activities.

Key Features:

- **Instant Setup:** Pre-attached poles allow for quick assembly, typically within 60 seconds.
- **Spacious Interior:** Dimensions of 120 x 108.2 x 74 inches provide comfortable standing room and accommodate up to 6 people.
- **Waterproof & Windproof:** Constructed from 150D Oxford cloth with 3000mm+ waterproof coating and taped seams for reliable weather protection.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, ensure all components are present in the package:

- Carry bag x 1
- Instant tent x 1
- Rain fly x 1
- Stakes x 12
- Wind ropes x 4
- Strapping x 1

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The Naturehike Cape 6 Person Tent features an instant setup design, allowing for quick and easy assembly. Follow these steps for proper installation:

1. **Unpack:** Remove the instant tent, rain fly, stakes, wind ropes, and strapping from the carry bag.
2. **Position the Tent:** Lay out the tent body on a flat, clear surface, ensuring there are no sharp objects underneath.
3. **Extend Poles:** The tent has pre-attached poles. Gently lift the tent and extend each of the four main poles to its full height until they lock into place. This will raise the tent structure.
4. **Secure the Base:** Once the tent is standing, use the 12 provided stakes to secure the base of the tent to the ground. Ensure the tent is taut.
5. **Attach Rain Fly:** Drape the rain fly over the tent. Secure it to the tent body using the designated clips or ties.
6. **Stabilize with Wind Ropes:** In windy conditions, attach the 4 wind ropes to the designated points on the tent and stake them firmly into the ground at an appropriate angle. Adjust the strapping as needed for additional support.

4. OPERATING THE TENT

Ventilation and Access:

The tent is designed with five-sided ventilation to ensure optimal airflow and reduce condensation. It features three large doors for easy entry and exit, and multiple windows for enhanced air circulation and scenic views. The top mesh skylight provides additional ventilation and a view of the night sky when the rainfly is open.

Interior Features:

Inside the tent, you will find two hooks for hanging lanterns or other lightweight items, and interior storage bags to keep your essentials organized and off the floor. The tent's tall design allows for comfortable standing and movement.

Awning Functionality:

The door curtains can be extended and supported with poles (not included) to create a canopy, sun shelter, or awning, providing additional shaded space outside the tent.

5. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

To clean your tent, use a soft brush or sponge with mild soap and lukewarm water. Avoid harsh detergents or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the fabric's waterproof coating. For spot cleaning, gently rub the affected area. For a full wash, hand wash the tent. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.

Drying:

Always ensure the tent is completely dry before packing it away. Packing a damp tent can lead to mildew growth and damage to the fabric. Hang the tent in a shaded, well-ventilated area until thoroughly dry.

Storage:

Store the tent in its carry bag in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure no heavy objects are placed on top of the packed tent to prevent damage to the poles or fabric.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Water Leakage:

The Naturehike Cape tent is designed to be waterproof with a 3000mm+ rating and taped seams. If you experience water leakage:

- **Check Rain Fly:** Ensure the rain fly is correctly positioned and taut over the tent, covering all mesh areas.
- **Inspect Seams:** Examine all seams for any signs of damage or wear. Re-seal any compromised seams with a seam sealer if necessary.
- **Close Openings:** Ensure all doors and windows are fully zipped and secured during rain.

Tent Instability in Wind:

If the tent feels unstable in windy conditions:

- **Proper Staking:** Ensure all 12 stakes are firmly driven into the ground.
- **Utilize Wind Ropes:** Always deploy and properly tension the 4 wind ropes to provide additional stability.
- **Pole Integrity:** Verify that all pre-attached poles are fully extended and locked into their correct positions.

Stuck Zippers:

If a zipper becomes difficult to operate, try applying a small amount of zipper lubricant or a graphite pencil lead to the teeth. Avoid forcing the zipper, as this can cause damage.

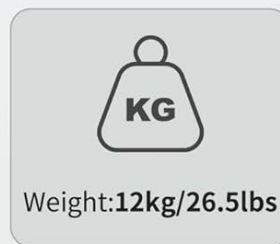
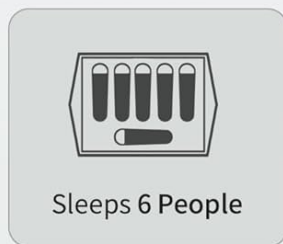
