## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS: CROCHETING YOUR FLAMINGO FAMILY

This section outlines the general process for crocheting your flamingo figures. For specific stitch instructions and pattern details, always refer to your kit's included written manuals and video tutorials.

### 1. Understanding the Pattern

The kit provides patterns for three flamingo figures: two larger flamingos and one smaller baby flamingo in a basket. Each pattern will specify the required yarn color, hook size, and stitch counts for each round or row.

## 2. Basic Crochet Stitches

- Magic Ring (or adjustable ring)
- Single Crochet (sc)
- Increase (inc)
- Decrease (dec)
- Slip Stitch (sl st)
- Chain (ch)

## 3. Crocheting the Body Parts

Follow the pattern for each flamingo, typically starting with the head and body, then moving to the neck and legs. Pay close attention to the stitch counts for each round to maintain the correct shape.

#### 4. Stuffing and Assembly

As you crochet, you will be instructed to stuff the body parts with the provided stuffing material. Ensure even stuffing to create a firm and well-shaped figure. Once all parts are crocheted and stuffed, use the yarn needle to sew them together according to the assembly instructions.

#### 5. Adding Details

Attach the safety eyes securely as indicated in the pattern. Use black yarn for the flamingo beaks and any other small details as per the design. The baby flamingo will also have a small brown basket to sit in.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your crochet tools and finished flamingo figures.

- **Finished Figures:** Hand wash gently with mild soap and cold water if necessary. Do not machine wash or tumble dry. Air dry flat to maintain shape. Avoid harsh chemicals or bleach.
- **Crochet Hooks:** Clean hooks with a soft, damp cloth. Store them in a dry place to prevent rust or damage.
- **Yarn:** Store unused yarn in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading or damage.
- **Safety Eyes:** Ensure safety eyes are firmly attached. If they become loose, re-secure them or remove them if the item is intended for very young children.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Here are some common issues beginners might encounter and how to address them:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty with stitches (too tight/loose)	Inconsistent tension; new to crocheting.	Practice basic stitches before starting the project. Watch video tutorials for visual guidance on tension. Relax your grip on the hook and yarn.
Yarn splitting	Hook catching individual plies of yarn; yarn quality.	Ensure your hook goes through the entire stitch. Try a slightly different hook size if available. Work slowly and carefully.
Figure shape is incorrect	Incorrect stitch count per round/row; missed increases/decreases.	Use stitch markers to mark the beginning of each round. Count your stitches frequently. If a mistake is found early, unravel and re-crochet the section.
Instructions are unclear	Learning style preference; specific terminology.	Refer to the step-by-step video tutorials provided with the kit. Search for supplementary beginner crochet videos online for specific stitches if needed.
